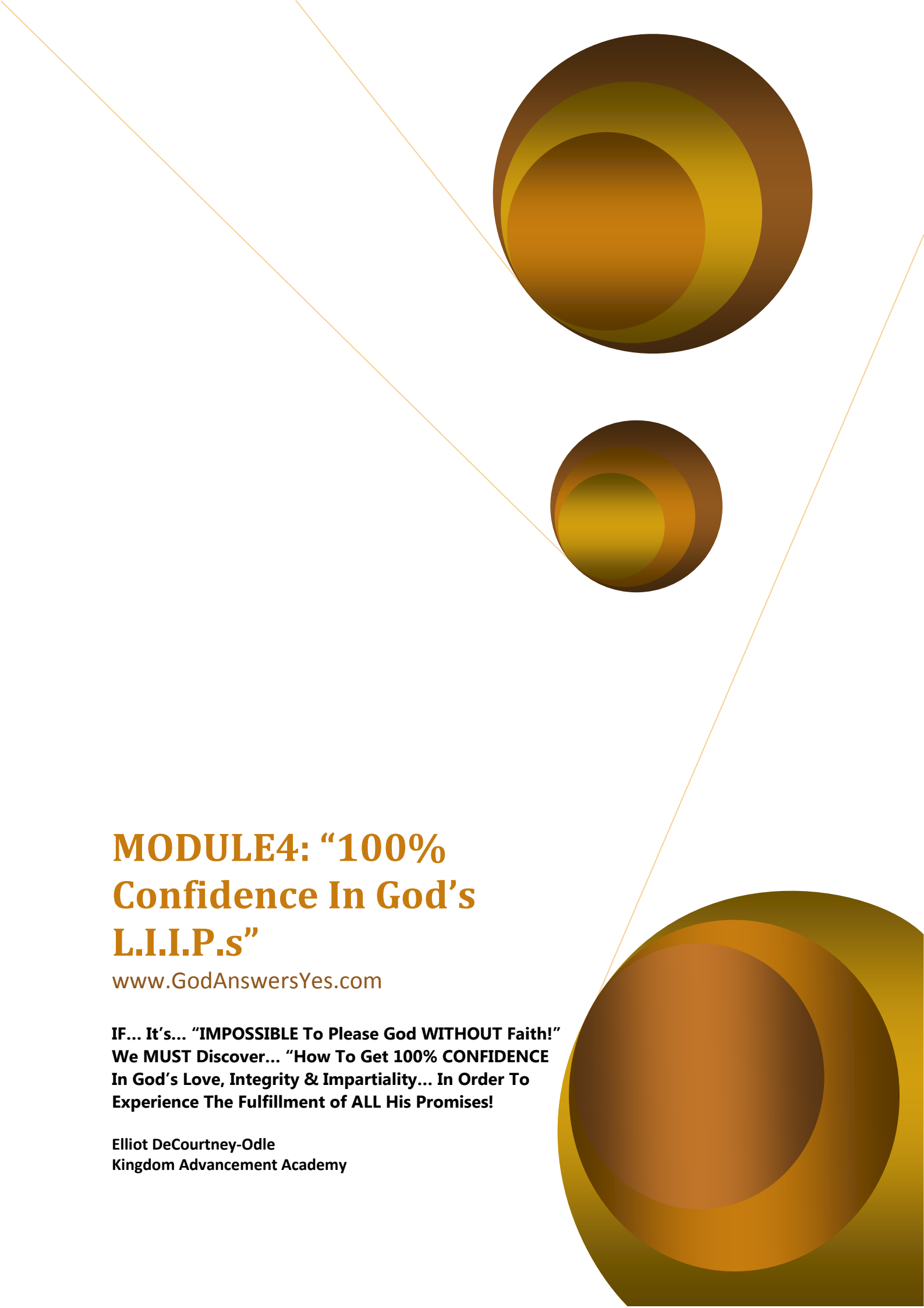

The scriptures above make it very clear that you are not an accident. God had your life all mapped out way before you were born. One vital stop on the highway of your life is the day you become his adopted child by accepting his offer to forgive your sins and save you for all eternity. The word "predestined" means that God planned everything out and made sure you got saved so you could be his daughter or son. And He promises to take care of you, whatever you need you only need to ask (Matthew7:7). And in God predestinating everything in your life, He says

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you. And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart. And I will be found of you, saith the LORD: and I will turn away your captivity" Jeremiah29:11-14,

God sent Jesus for your sake, because you were a sinner and unworthy of God, but yet He wanted to adopt you as His son or daughter and therefore made plans for your salvation. See even though you were born innocent, you were born a sinner. By Adam messing up we all went down with Him. "For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners..." Romans5:19. That's not fair you claim... well, God goes on to say in the same verse, "...by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous." Romans5:19.

"In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins." 1John4:9-10

And "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.." 1John1:9.

"It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness." Lamentations3:22-23. You are entitled to all this cos of merits of Christ. And it's only through His love that He allows you to use His merit's as your own.

"By the same misrepresentation of the character of God as he had practiced in heaven, causing Him to be regarded as a tyrant, Satan induced man to sin. Saying God's guidelines were unjust restrictions; and that led to man's fall."

And when man disobeyed God's law, his nature became evil, and he was in harmony with Satan. Satan and man both became evil through apostasy. If God hadn't intervened, man would have entered into an alliance with Satan against Heaven; and instead of cherishing the enmity God put between us against Satan, the whole human family would have been united in opposition to God.

When we choose to sin for ourselves, Romans6:16 says, "...to whom you yield yourself servants to obey, his servants you are to whom you obey; whether you are to whom you obey; whether of sin unto death or of obedience unto righteousness?"

It was WE who CHOSE not to follow God... and pledged allegiance to Satan, And instead of God getting the hump and saying, "fine if that's how you want it, well you can pay the wages of your sin, DEATH". God made plans to reconcile us to Him and didn't even tell us to pay for what WE had done. He took the responsibility upon Himself for the foolish mess we made for ourselves, AGAINST Him! He wanted to give you and I victory over the enemies power, which we in fact CHOSE to give him... and Jesus was willing to

degrade Himself by becoming mortal to DIE, to give us power over the enemy. Which we chose to obey.

So when Satan heard that God was putting enmity between himself and Eve, and between his seed and her seed, he knew that his efforts to deprave human nature would be interrupted; because now man was to be enabled to resist his power.

It's the grace that Christ implants in the soul which creates in man enmity against Satan. Without this converting grace and renewing power, man would continue to be the captive of Satan, a mere servant ever ready to do his bidding. The power which Christ imparts enables man to resist.

Now here's where the Love of God is mind boggling... Before man messed up or was even created, Christ knew we would reject obeying Him and we would choose to obey another master who didn't even create us, who was against Him. Yet He decided you know what I'm gonna leave heaven and go there.

If that were you or I we would have stayed right where we were... No not Jesus... let me tell you how much He loves you... Let me tell you what Christ had to go through to provide all this for you... The fact that He even left heaven baffles me, the very fact that He left... I can't get passed that. When it's cold outside and the weather is looking driery I'm not EVEN trying to leave my house. Now consider the contrast.

Jesus left INDESCRIBABLE glory... Indescribable... Where He was living in luxury, beyond what you can even comprehend, you've seen how billionaires live, well let me tell you that's dire poverty compared to where Jesus came from. The opulence and magnificent beauty He left to come here, is far beyond what you can even begin to imagine.

Not only that, He left a place, where He was adored and respected, by everyone there. A place where He was worshipped... He was equal with God Himself... yet He degraded Himself and left to save you. Paul put it perfectly in His letter to the Phillipian church and said... Jesus, "Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But **made** himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross." Phillipians2:6-8

Jesus left all that glory of both luxury AND love and respect and came through billions of galaxies to be in a human's womb and became of no reputation... and for your sake became poor that YOU through His poverty might be rich. (2Corinthians8:9)

KNOWING full well that when He arrived he wouldn't be received like He was accustomed to in Heaven, no no, He knew, ALTHOUGH He was the Son of the King of The universe, he would be despised, mocked, tortured and humiliated...



"The prince of evil exerted all his power to destroy Jesus... Satan contested every claim put forth by the Son of God and employed men as his agents to fill the Saviour's life with suffering and sorrow.... He made cruel accusations against him... He let loose of His envy and malice, hatred and

revenge, against the Son of God...

When the great sacrifice had been consummated, Christ ascended on high, refusing the adoration of angels until He had made His request to His Father: "I will that they also, whom Thou hast given Me, be with Me where I am." John17:24. "p501 Great Controversy.

Satan attacked Christ with his fiercest and most subtle temptations, but Christ for your sake repulsed Satan in every conflict. Those battles were fought in your behalf; those victories make it possible for you to conquer. Because Christ will give strength to all who seek it.

NOW... no man without his own consent can be overcome by Satan. The tempter has no power to control the will or to force the soul to sin. And here's the part where God has gone the extra million miles, God is faithful, who WILL NOT ALLOW you to be **tempted above** that you are **able to resist**; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be **able** to bear it. (1Corinthians10:13).

Here's the next mind boggling part... Even on the cross possessing the ability to save Himself Jesus stayed on it. He could have said, "Who do you insignificant filthy mortals think you are, do you know who I am!" and blitzed everyone of us as we deserved... No Jesus stayed and took the humiliation.

He said, **"Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do."**

Luke23:34 It must have been tempting for Jesus when people said, "...He saved others; let him save himself, if he be Christ, the chosen of God... And saying, If thou be the king of the Jews, save thyself." Luke23:35,37.

Now I could understand Him taking that if there was nothing He could do about it, but He WASN'T helpless, He could have said, "alright as you wish, you asked for it, I'm out of here" and let them have it and it would have been game over, for you and I, that would have been salvation out the window. He really didn't have to take what He went through, but He wanted to take us to be with in heaven so much, He took it.

And if you want proof, Jesus really had the power to deliver Himself, WATCH THIS! When Judas betrayed Jesus and they seized Him Peter cut off the right ear of one of the servants of the high priest (Matthew26:45-51), what did Jesus say? "Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword. Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall

presently give me more than twelve legions of angels? But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be?" Matthew 26:52-54

MORE than 12 legions of angels. 1 angel alone in 2 Kings 19:35 slew 185,000 men. Imagine what 12 legions or more would have done. A Legion by the way is 3,000-5,000, that's how Roman soldiers were arranged into legions. So 12 legions is 36,000-60,000 Angels. If each of them slew 185,000 men each they could have cleansed the earth of up to 11 billion men. The estimated population of men in Christ's time is around 200 million. 12 legions of angels would have been more than sufficient to do away with man kind for good. And if He wanted He could have called more than that. Hebrews 12:22 tells us angels are innumerable. Revelation 5:11 says, "...ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands..."

This is proof Jesus didn't have to go through any of this. He HAD power to stop it happening, He didn't, He humbled Himself to save YOU. He could have called those angels He created, "...his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word." Psalm 103:20. He could have called on them at any moment, but He cared more about making good on His promises in the scriptures to save you than He did about His own well being. How dare we think God doesn't care about us!

He was completely humiliated, God had to make the sun dark for 3 hours just to cover His nudity. And after it all. You know how He died? Of a BROKEN heart. We broke His heart. We broke His law... The point I want to make is Jesus knew all this would happen BEFORE He left. He Himself prophesied it thousands of years before it happened according to Isaiah 53.

"He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

... he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. Yet **it pleased** the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief..." Isaiah 53:3-6, 9-10

So Jesus knew, it wasn't like He came unprepared not knowing what to expect. He came knowing and He still left where He was to come here, to live among sinful wicked men. "It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed... his compassions... are new every morning..." Lamentations 3:22-23.

"For he hath **made** him to **be sin for us**, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him." 2Corinthians5:21 "For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous." Romans5:19.

And that's not it, even after we treated Him so badly. When He was resurrected, he didn't shoot off, He stayed 40 days and gave us instruction on the Kingdom of God, so we could be empowered and secured. He made us more promises as if He hadn't done enough already! Saying whatever you need... ask in my name and my Father will do it for you...

AND When He got to heaven, He sent the Holy Spirit to be with you, so that you could be closer to Him while He is away than we would be with Him still on earth. He even promised He would be with you, "Lo I am with you always, even to the end of the world" (Matthew28:20).

And even right NOW, He still cares. He is now making intercession for you, pleading the merits of His blameless blood which you by YOUR sin caused to be shed, to save YOU. So He left heaven to be treated as wicked, to bring wicked people who hated Him, who all disobeyed Him, to live with Him and live and be treated as He deserved. He said "Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, **be with me** where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me..." John17:24. He wants to bring us to the very place of indescribable glory He left to save us, to be with HIM. Where "...affliction shall not rise up the second time." Nahum1:9.

That's why David marvelled and said, "What is man that thou art mindful of Him." Psalm8:4 (He trekked through all those galaxies, for you. You have to understand, Who Jesus is and was and where He was coming from to save you FROM your sin and the consequences of your sin, to really appreciate His love for you. You have to understand Who God is and wonder why He would even permit all this to happen to His son.

Both The Father and Son have a shared interest and compassion, they love YOU

God knows the very number of hairs on your head. Assuming your parents love you dearly or assuming you who may be a parent love your children dearly, tell me? At any point did you take an interest in knowing the number of hairs on your child's head? Did your parents take an interest in keeping count of the number of hairs on your head? God does... He cares about you and the minutest detail of your life, that your parents never took an interest in, yet we sometimes have more confidence that our parents guardians and friends will take care of us, more than God, who has made us promises, He will do so.

He took stripes on His back that you may be healed and after all that we question if God really loves us? Now I literally said all that to make this one point right here: If God went through all that trouble to save you, why would granting a simple request even be an issue?

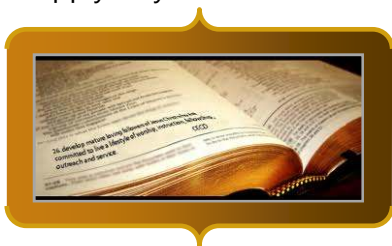
Trust me everything else is a minor issue in comparison to sacrificing His son, which was the biggest gift he could have given...)

And God wants to give you a rich and lavish inheritance. He put Jesus through all that so He could give it to you, and He would very much like you to take advantage of EVERY thing He provided. In fact He says to you, "forget not all His benefits" Psalm103:2. He made them for you. His benefits are ALL the promises He made in His Word. He wants to give you them ALL.

He said ask and ye shall receive, whatsoever you desire ask believe you receive WHEN you pray and you shall have them. He said, you have not because you ask not. Everyone that asks receives, He promisesd whatever you ask I'll do it, whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. Now Romans8:32 says, "He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?". Every good gift every perfect gift comes from the Father James1:17. And God will withhold no good thing from them that walk uprightly Psalms84:11.

But yet we wanna think God doesn't care about us, "But Zion said, The LORD hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me. Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee. Behold, I have graven thee upon the palms of my hands; thy walls are continually before me." Isaiah49:14-16

God said in Hebrews13:5, "I will **never** leave thee, nor forsake thee." David said, "I have been young, and now am old; yet have I **not** seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread." Psalm37:25. "bread shall be given him; his waters shall be **sure**." Isaiah33:16. "He shall supply all your need according to HIS riches in glory..." Phil4:19. David said, "I had fainted, unless I had **believed** to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living." Psalm27:13. You must believe.



"Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?" **Matthew7:7-11**

"He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?" Romans8:32.

"For the salvation of a fallen and sinful race, the King of the universe had made the greatest sacrifice which love could make; "God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself." 2Corinthians5:19... Christ had, in order to destroy sin, humbled Himself and become obedient unto death. My friend, God is MORE than willing to give you anything you ask for, when you ask according to His promises. God is as sure to keep His promises as He is His law of gravity.

Lucifer knew God was a God of integrity and knew therefore God would not violate His own Word. And so Satan declared that if the Law of God was changeless, and its penalty could not be remitted, every transgressor must be forever debarred from the Creator's favor. He had claimed that the sinful race were placed beyond redemption and were therefore his rightful prey. But the death of Christ was an argument in man's behalf that could not be overthrown. The penalty of the law fell upon Him who was equal with God, and man was free to accept the righteousness of Christ" p502-503 The Great Controversy

Why did Christ have to die? Well He didn't have to, it was His choice He made out of a loving heart. Here's the thing. When God sets a law He can't change it. He is the Lord who changes not. He will not break His covenant nor alter the thing that has gone out of His lips. Now He stated that the wages of sin is death. His law, was and is immutable ("immutable" means it can't be changed) and disobedience to the law otherwise known as transgression of the law. Means the penalty has to be paid, it's law. Like gravity is a law which states anything heavier than air is attracted to the center of earth... The wages of any sin is death, that's also a law. So when sin is committed the penalty of "DEATH" must be paid. So when Adam sinned, for us, it meant eternal death, the end, forever, finished, Finito, GAME OVER!

So Jesus chose to pay YOUR wages FOR YOUR transgression against the law, which HE, HIMSELF set. It's His law He could have said, "you violated it you pay it." But His love came into play, He didn't want YOU to perish. But yet there is still the issue of His unchangeable law. So he being the person of integrity who holds His Word above His own name said, "the law is the law, I can't change that, the penalty must be paid!" Satan WAS right about that!

So He said, **"the wages WILL be paid... I'll pay the wages, I'll die for them, in their place."** He kept His Word even to His own hurt. He was under no obligation to do this, you have to understand that part. He should have and would have been perfectly within His rights to let you pay the penalty for your own sins. But He said no, no I'll pay it and anyone who believes in my Son doesn't have to pay the wages of His sin, if He will repent and turn from His wicked ways and accept my son's blood, then my Son's sacrifice will be an Atonement for their sin. "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil" Hebrews2:14

Now If God wouldn't change His law and ALLOWED His son to die in order to keep it. It's NO big deal for Him to keep His Word and making good on His promises, which you claim. He will treat His promises to you just as seriously as He TREATED His law and let His Son die.

- NO CONDEMNATION -

You do not need to add on what Jesus DID. What He did satisfied God. So when you accept Jesus as your Saviour, His merits are appropriated to you, AS YOUR OWN. God doesn't deal with you according to your worthiness, but just as if you were Jesus Himself. That's why Jesus said when you pray (John16:23) Ask in My name and The Father will give you what you ask for.

I want you to imagine a so called friend convinced you to sin and then deliberately stiched you up and got you summons to court, you are tried and the Jury unanimously charges you "guilty". The judge gives you your sentence "eternal death without resurrection".

You're so called friend says, **"Check Mate, it's game over for you buddy"**

Then before you are escorted to be executed, the judge says, "hold on", because the judge's son burst in the court room "NO..." let me take their punishment. "Kill me spare them." The court room stares in awe, waiting for the response from the Judge, who to your surprise says, "very well".

Then Jesus says, "Your Honour, wait one more thing." The judge says, "Yes Son". "He says I want you to treat them as you would treat me... Now as you know Father I have power over death so, when I'm resurrected I want them to be with me!" The judge says "ok... if the defendant (that's you) will accept, it will be as you have said my Son". Jesus says, "Yes your Honour" Your so called friend said, "Check Mate" but the mercy of the Judge and His Son said, "No YOU have one more move".

So the judge says, **"Will you accept the sacrifice of my Son, to be free of sin, all guilt and entitlement to all His privileges?"**. What would you say? You have a chance to be let off Scott Free. All you have to say is, "Yes I accept". Well I would say, "Yes". I hope you would to! If you have given your life to Jesus then that's what you HAVE done...

Then Jesus goes off to be executed and the judge has His chauffeur pick you up and takes you to His house and puts you in Jesus' room. With servants waiting on you hand and foot. And He Lo and behold He treats you as if you never did wrong, as if your wrong never killed His Son and He extends every privilege to you that He would give to Jesus. As long as you ask in His name. You get the Full use of the inheritance, God provided for His Son.

Well that's reality. Hard to Fathom but it's reality. Yes you are undeserving but that's the deal Jesus cut for you, He hooked you up and He wants you to take advantage of it ALL. And as you and I are speaking He is asking The Father to grant the requests you have made.

There is no condemnation to you whatsoever. Anytime you ask for anything! God answers you according to the worthiness of His Son who He loves.

"Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah...He asked life of thee, and thou gavest it him, even length of days for ever and ever... For thou hast made him most blessed for ever: thou hast made him exceeding glad with thy countenance. For the king trusteth in the LORD, and through the mercy of the most High he shall not be moved." Psalm21:2,4,6-7.

When God doesn't hear your request it's because of what is said in (Isaiah59:1-2,12-13). Now we have an advocate with the Father. So if you repent according to 1John1:9. He offers forgiveness and when you're forgiven you are in right standing with God. He is "...merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin..." Exodus34:6-7.

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for our's only, but also for the sins of the whole world." 1John1:9, 1John2:1-2,

"But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.... Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy" Jude20-21,24.

Once you have repented, you are given the right to feel relief from ALL misery and guilt, God says, "I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more." Hebrews8:12.

God is willing to grant you unmerited favour. God is a compassionate person, you need compassion to even do that. He knows you are undeserving but He is willing to treat you as though you are deserving as Jesus who never did any wrong. And so you can go boldly to the throne OF GRACE and ask for forgiveness and OBTAIN mercy guilt free (Hebrews4:16). and God sees you as clean through Jesus and He will hear you and sees you in right standing with Him.

God showed THIS to John the Revelator and told Him to record it just for you, so you know that your prayers do in fact reach the throne of God Himself. "And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets. And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand." Revelation8:2-4.

So **God hears your prayers and according to His will**, "...the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly." Psalm84:11.

Don't be afraid go **BOLDLY** Hebrews4:16. He says, "Come **NOW**, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow." Isaiah1:18 "I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more." Hebrews8:12

I want to read a quote from a book called, **The Great Controversy pages477-478** it says, "While the Christian's life will be characterized by humility, it should not be marked with sadness and self-depreciation. It is the privilege of everyone so to live that God will approve and bless him. It is not the will of our heavenly Father that we should be ever under condemnation and darkness. There is no evidence of true humility in going with the head bowed down and the heart filled with thoughts of self. We may go to Jesus and be cleansed, and stand before the law without shame and remorse. "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit." Romans 8:1.

Through Jesus the fallen sons of Adam become "sons of God." "Both He that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause He is not ashamed to call them brethren." Hebrews 2:11. The Christian's life should be one of faith, of victory, and joy in God. "Whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith." 1John5:4. Truly spoke God's servant Nehemiah: "The joy of the Lord is your strength." Nehemiah 8:10. And Paul says: "Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice." "Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." Philippians 4:4; 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18." p477-478 **The Great Controversy**



Page 483 of the same book says, "All who have truly repented of sin, and by faith claimed the blood of Christ as their atoning sacrifice, have had pardon entered against their names in the books of heaven; as they have become partakers of the righteousness of Christ, and their characters are found to be in harmony with the law of God, their sins will be blotted out, and they themselves will be accounted worthy of eternal life. The Lord declares, by the prophet Isaiah: **"I, even I, am He**

that blotteth out thy transgressions for Mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins." Isaiah 43:25. Said Jesus: "He that overcometh, the same shall

be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before My Father, and before His angels." "Whosoever therefore shall confess Me before men, him will I confess also before My Father which is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny Me before men, him will I also deny before My Father which is in heaven." Revelation3:5; Matthew 10:32, 33." p483 **Great Controversy**

Pages484-485 says, "The divine Intercessor presents the plea that all who have overcome through faith in His blood be forgiven their transgressions, that they be restored to their Eden home, and crowned as joint heirs with Himself to "the first dominion." Micah4:8. Satan in his efforts to deceive

and tempt our race had thought to frustrate the divine plan in man's creation; but Christ now asks that this plan be carried into effect as if man had never fallen. He asks for His people not only pardon and justification, full and complete, but a share in His glory and a seat upon His throne.

While Jesus is pleading for the subjects of His grace, Satan accuses them before God as transgressors. The great deceiver has sought to lead them into skepticism, to cause them to lose confidence in God, to separate themselves from His love, and to break His law. Now he points to the record of their lives, to the defects of character, the unlikeness to Christ, which has dishonored their Redeemer, to all the sins that he has tempted them to commit, and because of these he claims them as his subjects.

Jesus does not excuse their sins, but shows their penitence and faith, and, claiming for them forgiveness, He lifts His wounded hands before the Father and the holy angels, saying: I know them by name. I have graven them on the palms of My hands. "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, Thou wilt not despise." Psalm 51:17. And to the accuser of His people He declares: "The Lord rebuke thee, O Satan; even the Lord that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: is not this a brand plucked out of the fire?" Zechariah 3:2. Christ will clothe His faithful ones with His own righteousness, that He may present them to His Father "a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing." Ephesians 5:27. Their names stand enrolled in the book of life, and concerning them it is written: "They shall walk with Me in white: for they are worthy." Revelation 3:4.

Thus will be realized the complete fulfillment of the new-covenant promise: "I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more." "In those days, and in that time, saith the Lord, the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found." Jeremiah 31:34; 50:20. "In that day shall the branch of the Lord be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel. And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, even everyone that is written among the living in Jerusalem." Isaiah 4:2, 3." **p484-485**



"Jesus pleads in their behalf His wounded hands, His bruised body; and He declares to all who would follow Him: "My grace is sufficient for thee." 2 Corinthians 12:9. "Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto

your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light." Matthew 11:29, 30. Let none, then, regard their defects as incurable. God WILL give faith and grace to overcome them."

"Seek the Lord while He may be found, Call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, and he will have mercy on him; and to our God for he will abundantly pardon." Isaiah 55:6-7

He pleads with you to turn to Him to accept His forgiveness and feel free of guilt. Free of doubt that He loves you and has forgiven you. He went to a lot of trouble to make forgiveness available to you. So He WANTS you to have it, MORE than you want to take it.

He is heart broken and disappointed any time His children who He loves are deceived by the enemy, into thinking they aren't forgiven or loved.

He really made every expense possible to give you victory over sin and over your guilt for committing it, and now **He wants you to take the message of His love and grace to others.** And WILL MAKE every heavenly provision available at your disposal to get the job done. His Favour, His Holy Spirit, His angels, His promises... all have been provided to help you and He wants you to take advantage of it all, Fully exploiting His EVERY resource. He will supply ALL your needs according to His riches in glory.

When you ask in the name of His Son Jesus according to His will, according to His promises. Whatsoever you ask you can be confident that you have been granted requests you made...

God Answers YES!!!

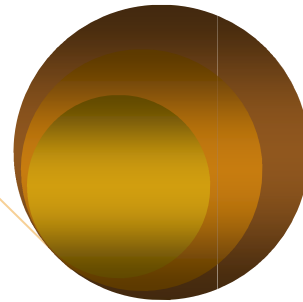
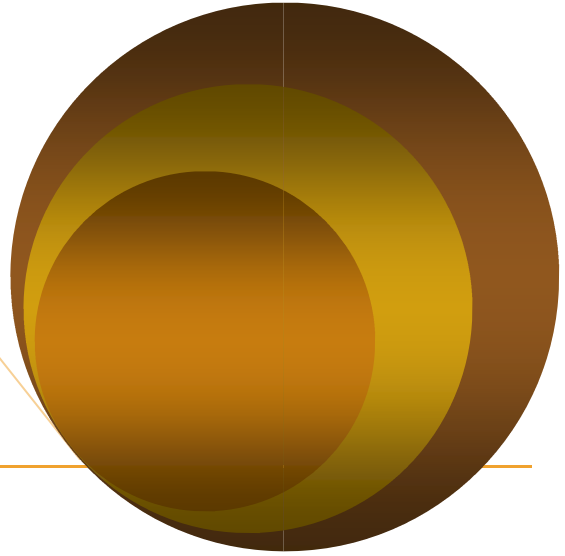

Ok Welcome to part 2 of Module 4 100% Confidence in God's L.I.I.P.s

In the 1st part of this module we spoke about God's LOVE for you and how willing and actually desperate He is to bless you and how vitally important it is to know that, in order to pray a prayer OF FAITH! And each prayer you pray NEEDs to be IN FAITH because without faith it is IMPOSSIBLE to please God...

God said, "...To day if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your hearts, as... in the day of temptation in the wilderness: When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years. Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways. So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.)

Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. **For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;**

And to whom swore he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not? So we see that they could not enter in **because of unbelief.**" Hebrews3:7-14, 18-19.

"Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but **the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.**

³*For we which have believed do enter into rest... Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief."* **Hebrews4:1-3, 11.**

Falling into unbelief means your prayers will be without faith and therefore displeasing to God. The Bible encourages you and I to encourage each other daily, so we won't be hardened. The Word will not profit you if it is "not being mixed with faith". So what you and I are going to be doing is labouring in The Word of God, so we can enter into a restful state of certain confidence and stay there! Now that we have confidence of God's unfathomable Love the next component you NEED to be certain of is the SERIOUSNESS of God's sincere and unmatched **Integrity...**

Did you know; God actually holds His Word... ABOVE His own name (Psalm138:2)! That's pretty deep... Now as if His name wasn't great enough. He holds the Word's He speaks above His very name.

We are going to be studying the most important attributes of God's Word. And I believe when you understand this, and meditate on it and saturate yourself in it, you will reach the place where your confidence in ANY promise of God can not be shaken PERIOD! I don't care what happens. And as you do that, you'll find yourself becoming more obedient to what God asks of you because, you are so confident in God's Word you literally survive by it.

The Just shall LIVE by Faith. Well faith comes by hearing The Word of who? The Word of God. The just shall live by FAITH in what God has said. Man shall not live by bread alone but by EVERY word that proceeds out of the mouth of God. EVERY word, which is why God says, "forget not ALL His benefits"...

So here's a brief overview of what you are going to learn today...

- **God CAN'T lie**
- **He keeps His Word to His OWN Hurt**
- **God submits Himself to His own laws and binds Himself to them.** He does this for YOUR benefit, so that YOU can have every confidence in obeying Him.
- **Unless you claim His promise, He can't do anything, your request must be according to something HE said IS His will**
- **He will not do anything WITHOUT your granting Him permission BY YOUR requests**
- **God's Will doesn't automatically happen just because it's His Will**
- **God Promises NOTHING He Can't Deliver**
- God Won't... Change
- The Word of God is DIFFERENT from ANY other Word. Man's Word is declarative. However GOD'S WORD has "CREATIVE" power to change your life.

Ok so let's get into it...

One of the first things I knew about God was that **"He can't lie"** therefore what He promises WILL be done. Even if He did lie which is **impossible** for Him to do. It would BECOME true just because HE said it...

I want you to be certain of the fact that God is a keeper of His Word and that when YOU claim His promise. As long as you co-operate with Him as a co-laborer. His Word WILL be fulfilled. "Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, **after ye have done** the will of God, ye might receive the promise." Hebrews 10:35-36

"For **God** is not *unrighteous to forget* your work and **labour** of love, which ye have shewed toward his name..." Hebrews 6:10

God is MORE than willing to give you anything you ask for, when you ask according to **His** promises. Because it's His Word and He can't lie, when YOU claim it, yes YOU... He is obligated to fulfill it. And... God is as sure to keep His promises to YOU as He is His law of gravity. And just as God's law of gravity works for everyone, His promises will work for everyone, nobody is exempt. In part 3 we will study how imparital God is...

Now even Lucifer knew God was a Being of integrity and knew therefore that God **would not** under any circumstances violate His own Word. Which is why Satan tried to claim mankind as his rightful prey after we obeyed him and denied our Creator. Now the wages of sin IS death and God cannot deny His own law. So Satan thought He had God cornered! It would seem God is in a bit of a cuffed state...

But praise God, since He is so intelligent. He knew a way to keep His Word, obey His law... AND get man off the hook! With God all things are possible! Remember that next time you have a problem. Watch this...

"ONLY one who was EQUAL with the law..." was able to die on your behalf! But in order for the sacrifice to actually be valid, the person being the sacrifice had to be of the same kind as the one's who violated the law. In other Words it was a MAN who had to pay man's penalty. But that man had to be equal with the law to... Not only that but the man who was going to do this had to

keep the law, not breaking it ONCE, so that the sacrifice was flawless. "For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all." James2:10

So the only logical solution was God Himself had to become a man... And obey His own law, His whole life and die paying man's penalty. But since He was still technically equal with the law. It meant man would be off the hook; on the condition that they accepted His sacrifice and His merits as their own... for their redemption!

So even the law-maker couldn't go back on His Word but being EQUAL to His Word which set His law... was able to pay the penalty and get you off the hook. The person paying the penalty HAD to be equal to the law itself for your redemption to be valid. Otherwise one of the angels could have done it. But He became "lower than the angels" to become a man. So God was able to keep His Word AND deliver you at the same time. Because He is equal to the law and He became equal with man and He made good on His Word which Only He was equal to... GENIUS... GENIUS!

But it still cost God something, He had to watch His own Son be degraded, tortured and He had to refrain from intervening, so we could have our shot at being reconciled to Him. So this tells us something else about God... He will NOT lie AND He keeps His Word to His OWN Hurt. See that's the difference between God and Satan.

"Satan wants to exalt himself at ANY cost to others... but God wants to exalt others at any cost to Himself"

Now, I said that to say this... If God wouldn't change His law and allowed His son to die in order to keep it. It's no big deal for Him to keep His Word and make good on His promises, which you claim. He will treat His promises to you just as seriously as He kept His law and let His Son die. But it is still up to you to meet His requirements which we covered in module 2. You are in a partnership with God.

"For we are **labourers** together with **God.**" 1Corinthians3:9 "after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise." Hebrews10:35-36

But right now we are talking about God's side of the equation, because if you HAVE met all God's requirements... NOW you need to rest assured confident God WILL do His part.

And I know people are quick to say, "Oh yeah God is a God of integrity" But do YOU really believe that? Because if you did, there are probably a lot of things, that you do at the moment or don't do, that you should or shouldn't be doing, and the only reason you ARE doing it is out of fear that God won't do as He has promised. You don't REALLY trust God yet! Because you haven't learnt to...

And really as much as it WILL help you, me telling you how much God is faithful to His Word, there comes a point where, it's just you and God and you need to just trust Him and obey! And it takes confidence to do that... And the process starts by KNOWING about God's Integrity from His Word

(faith comes by hearing) and ultimately your confidence will come when you take God at His Word! Because when you do He WILL come through for you and you will have your own experiences to look back on and now when God gives you an instruction, you have become accustomed to taking Him at His Word, so your habit to say. Ok I know it looks like if obey God “abc” will happen, but His Word promises “xyz” so I’m taking God at His Word.

-----**(SEE My Mother’s Testimony)**-----

God submits Himself to His own laws **and**

binds Himself to them. He does this for YOUR benefit, so that YOU can have every confidence in obeying Him. This is why He has every right to claim, His “commandments are not griveous”. He regards the laws He set above Himself, “...for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.” Psalm138:2.

God will not violate His Word. This is why it’s so important YOU pray according to HIS will. Because He can’t do anything outside it. He is bound to His will, because of His integrity to KEEP **HIS** Word.

Unless you claim HIS promise, He can’t do anything, your request must be according to something HE said IS His will. That’s how God operates and that WILL NEVER change... “For I am the LORD, I **change not...**” Malachi 3:6 “...my lovingkindness will I not utterly take... nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie...” Psalm89:33-35

God submits Himself to His own laws and binds Himself to them. He regards the laws He set above Himself, (which means He doesn’t see Himself above His law or thinks that He is the only one who doesn’t need to keep it, if He doesn’t find it convnient to do so, He WILL keep His Word to His own Hurt). The psalmist wrote “...for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.” Psalm138:2. God will not violate anything He says. That’s why it’s important you pray back to God WHAT **HE** says.

And This is why it’s so important that YOU... are to pray.... Because although God has His will which HE WANTS, implemented in this earth. **He has submitted Himself AND the resources of His Kingdom to YOUR asking for His intervention.** Remember He said in Genesis that He would give man dominion over the earthly realm. He said, “let THEM have dominion”. Psalm115:16 says, “Ye are blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth. The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD’s: but the **earth** hath he given to the children of **men**.”

And since God has said this and He holds His Word above His name... Although He made heaven and earth. **He needs YOUR permission to do things in this earth for you or through you.** That’s why He asks you to surrender to Him. Otherwise He will stay out of your affairs unless you invite Him in. He is a gentleman He won’t wait impose Himself or His agenda on you, if you don’t want it. **He will not do anything WITHOUT your granting Him permission BY YOUR request...**

But when you do Paul says, "BE CAREFUL FOR NOTHING; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with **thanksgiving** let your **requests** be made known unto God." Philippians4:6

You see what you have to understand is that, God's Will doesn't automatically happen just because it's His Will. If that were the case then explain 2Peter3:9 "The Lord is... not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." Yet men perish daily without coming to repentance. So here we see God's will doesn't always come to pass and it's not because He is slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us," Men are perishing because WE are supposed to "Go... preach the gospel" so that men don't perish.

So often God's will doesn't come to pass and it's nothing to do with Him not keeping His promise. But because, He said, "AFTER **you** have done the will of God you might receive the promise." If **you haven't done** the Will you can't receive. In many cases doing the will is asking God to get involved. "...we are labourers together with God..." 1Corinthians3:9

So When you ask you are co-operating with God's will, This gives God permission to get involved in earthly affairs. Your asking Helps God to fulfill His will. That's how you can be certain God will answer "YES" to your prayers. This is why Jesus taught the disciples to pray, "Thy kingdom come, Thy **will** be done in **earth**, as it is in **heaven**." Matthew6:10



"Thus saith the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, **Ask...** concerning the work of my hands command ye me." Isaiah45:11, "...I will give unto YOU the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever YOU shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever YOU shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

Matthew16:19. So when you pray or declare God's will, you allow God to operate through you and God "...confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers" Isaiah44:26.

So when you speak and you see what you say come to pass it's because of God "That **confirmeth** the **word** of his **servant**," It's not because you have power, but God adding His power to your Words in line with His Will. He adds His SUPER on your natural.

What God is saying here is He will back whatever you say which is in line with His will and HE will perform it. This is why it is important you "say" HIS Word. Because you can speak but God won't get involved if it's not His will. So you both must be in agreement. And when you speak or pray His Word. God says, "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." Isaiah55:11

When you speak "...his angels, that excel in strength, ...do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word." Psalm103:20. "According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:" 2Peter1:3. And He says "...forget not all his benefits" Psalm103:2. God wants to grant you every heavenly resource and benefit to exploit at your disposal to accomplish His work!

"THOU hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah...He asked life of thee, and THOU gavest it him, even length of days for ever and ever... For thou hast made him most blessed for ever: thou hast made him exceeding glad with thy countenance. For the king trusteth in the LORD, and through the mercy of the most High he shall not be moved." Psalm21:2,4,6-7.

One divine law is freedom of choice which God will not violate. God takes no pleasure in forced allegiance. So He will not interfere in your affairs where YOU don't call. But when you do He gets involved. He "hastens to perform His Word." And in fact He knew when you would ask anyway, so He makes the provision for your request for His Promises to be fulfilled BEFORE you ask. He gets a head start. BEFORE you call He answers. But you MUST MAKE IT **YOUR BUSINESS TO ASK**. "...ye have **not**, because ye **ask not**." James4:2 And He needs your faith in Him for it to happen. "...without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." Hebrews11:6

An inspired writer says this, "...Were not miracles wrought by Christ and His apostles? The same compassionate Saviour lives today, and He is as willing to listen to the prayer of faith as when He walked visibly among men. The natural cooperates with the supernatural. It is a part of God's plan to grant us, in answer to the prayer of faith, that which He would not bestow did we not thus ask."

p525 The Great Controversy

Now Here is another fascinating fact about God's Word... "God Promises NOthing He Can't Deliver!!!" So much so that God is so confident in His own Word; that BEFORE He delivers *He speaks about things as if they already exist*. God said to Abraham, when He was childless; "...I have made thee a father of many nations," When God said this Abraham's wife was barren at the time and he himself was really old. Yet, "God, who quickeneth the dead" "calleth those things which be not as though they were." (Romans4:17).

"Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:" **Isaiah46:10**.

And God can do that because He makes provision for EVERY promise He ever makes WAY in advance. "According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:" 2Peter1:3

"I have declared the former things from the beginning; and they went forth out of my mouth, and I shewed them; I did them suddenly, and they came to pass." **Isaiah48:3**.

Let me give you another example, that I think you will find intriguing, here is something God hasn't delivered YET but He will. But it proves God prepares to deliver on what He promises WAY **in advance**. John "The Revelator" recorded in one of His visions, what would happen right before Jesus comes take us home. Part of what He will do is send plagues on the wicked to avenge the wrong they have done to His people.

"...For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets... ..and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great." **Revelation16:6,19-21**

Now this hail John saw fall upon the wicked, has already been reserved, it actually exists today and has done for some time! Watch this Job38:22 says; "Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail". Now if you didn't know... chronologically Job was the first book ever written in the Bible. "Behold, to morrow about this time I will cause it to rain a very grievous hail, such as hath not been in Egypt since the foundation thereof even until now." Exodus9:18.

So remember this if you ever can't see God's way of working something out, just rest ASSURED. That even though it hasn't been delivered the provision is ALREADY there! You can trust God has already worked out how His promise will come to pass for you before you even claimed the promise.

God Won't... Change & He CAN'T Lie

"For I am the LORD, I **change not...**" Malachi 3:6

"...my lovingkindness will I not utterly take... nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie..." **Psalms89:33-35**

The psalmist wrote "...praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name." **Psalms 138:2** He is "...the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning." **James1:17**.

"Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it." **Jeremiah1:12**. God said, "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." **Isaiah55:11**

Can't Lie

So when God says, something in His Word, we ought to believe it, take Him by it, hold Him to it, obey it and LIVE by it. But we need to labour in His Word to obtain the confidence necessary to do so. "...be not slothful, but followers of them who **through faith and patience inherit the promises**. For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, **he swore by himself**, Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.

And so, after he (Abraham) had patiently endured, he obtained the promise. For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife. Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability (The unchangeableness) of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:

That by two immutable things, in which **it was impossible for God to lie**, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: ¹⁹Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast..." Hebrews6:12-19.

God said, "Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will **not lie...**" Psalm 89:35

God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?" **Numbers23:19.**

"The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.
Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever." **Psalms12:6-7.**

God's Word... Words are life, life and life abundantly. (That's why I say if you don't pray the promises of God you're not praying).

God's oath and covenant, are unchangeable. God IS truth so it's impossible for Him to go contrary to what He is. Which is why it's impossible for Him to lie.

What God says is true because HE IS the truth. What God says is always true because He IS always true so if God gives us a promise, and it's impossible for Him to lie, then the receiving of that promise means it depends on our believing the promise.

So when He makes a promise, you don't have to question the promise, it's to be accepted and acted on as though you KNOW when you do, the promise although unmanifested and invisible, is as good as fulfilled.

When I said I would give you this package if you go to www.godanswersyes.com/go.html you went there in faith that what I said was true and you would find my word fulfilled, you demonstrated your faith in my word **by your action**. Faith without corresponding action is dead. And by your faith and action you received.

Well the same is true with God. In fact even more so with God. I'm a man who can lie, He can't. When He has made a promise, it is true, so you must act accordingly and His promise will be fulfilled. "Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise." Hebrews10:35-36. God's promises require your obedience in order to be fulfilled. YOUR only concern should be what is God's command and what is His promise.

God's Words of Integrity Possess Creative Power

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. ...Through faith we understand that **the worlds were framed by the word of God**, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear." **Hebrews11:1,3.**

"...thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light... Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: For **by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth**, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: **all things were created by him**, and for him: And he is before all things, and by him all things consist." **Colossians1:12,15-17.**

According to John 1:1 God IS The Word, so let's read the same text with the Word. "For by (His WORD) were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by (His WORD), and for him: And (His WORD) is before all things, and by (His WORD) all things consist." **Colossians 1:16-17.**

"And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in **God, who created all things** by Jesus Christ." **Ephesians 3:9.**

"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters." **Genesis 1:1-2.**

"For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; **God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it**, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else." **Isaiah 45:18.**

"Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, **by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever**. For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: But **the word of the Lord endureth for ever**. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you." **1 Peter 1:23-25.**

"And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.⁵ For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:



⁶Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished.⁷ But the heavens and the earth, which are now, **by the same word are kept in store**, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men." **2 Peter 3:4-7.**

God "Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed *heir of all things*, by whom also he made the worlds; Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and **upholding all things by the word of his power**

...And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands: **They shall perish; but thou remainest**; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment; And as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail." **Hebrews 1:2-3, 10-12.**

FACINATING Facets of God's Word Continued...

"**By the word of the LORD were the heavens made**; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth. He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the depth in

storehouses. Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him. *For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.*” **Psalm33:6-9**

God said, “So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.” **Isaiah55:11**

God’s Word creates what He declares... Jesus said, “ the **words** that I speak unto you, they are **spirit**, and they are **life**.” John 6:63. The promises made to us by God to transform our lives, contain the SAME Creative energies that created this planet. They were spoken by the same lips. So the writer of Hebrews said, “Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised.” **Hebrews10:23**

The Word of God is DIFFERENT from ANY other Word.

Man’s Word is declarative. However GOD’S WORD is “CREATIVE”. A man can say “this is a computer.” God can say, “This IS a Computer” when there was no computer and The Word He speaks creates a computer. “For the word of God is quick (living), and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.” Hebrews4:12.

The Word of God has 2 attributes it is “LIVING” and it is “POWERfull”. David prayed, “Plead my cause, and deliver me: quicken (give life or revive) me according to thy word.” Psalm119:154.

How was this world created? “By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth. ...For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.” Psalm33:6,9

God’s Word is SO powerful, that what He says “IS” so, even if it wasn’t before, because when HE says it, it becomes so. God’s Word is so powerful that when He speaks the Word that comes out of His Mouth BECOMES tangible substance. When God says, “let there be light” and there never was before, when that Word comes out of His mouth, it creates that which He declares, because His Word is living and full of power.

HIS Word has creative power. This is a very important truth to bear in mind when you claim a promise from the WORD of God. Because His promises contain the same living creative energy and power, as there was when God said, “Let there be light and there WAS...” The same Word that spoke worlds into existence, contains the SAME power in the WRITTEN Word TODAY!

God said at creation, “Let the Sun Shine and dispell the darkness” we SEE evidence God’s Word had creative power and created the thing He spoke. All those things, “...by the same word are kept in store.” **2Peter3:4-7**. God is “...upholding all things by the word of his power...” **Hebrews1:3** and He to THIS day upholds His promises.

In His WRITTEN Word to you He says, "Let My Sun of Righteousness, shine in the darkness of YOUR HEART". God created fruit trees and God promises you, His Word will create, "The fruit of the Spirit in your character. The Word of God has the creative power to transform your life and your heart.

When you accept any promise of God by Faith. The promise contains within it the power of God; to accomplish the agenda of the promise you claim by faith. So when we read for example, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, **and** to cleanse us from **all** unrighteousness."

That is a legal declaration of Heaven. When you grasp that promise by faith, that promise spoken by the same lips which created planets, carries with it THE SAME POWER to create in your mind peace and freedom from guilt. Every promise claimed by faith has power to create a divine reality within you and the divine reality is YOU ARE NO LONGER GUILTY. It's not only something you believe but a real tangible reality which changes your brain cells.

So when for example you are struggling with some sin in your life, and you read in Phillipians4:13, "I CAN do ALL things THROUGH Christ which STRENGTHENS me" By accepting that promise and BY Faith internalising in your mind, that living Word which is a seed, which creates new brain cells, new neurological pathways in YOUR brain; Through The Word of God, those OLD sins are dispelled! Because there is a recreation by that living powerful Word.

That's why the scripture says, "And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God." Romans12:2. "For this is the covenant that I will make... saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:" Hebrews10:8

"But we all, with open face **beholding** as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are **changed** into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord." 2Corinthians3:18 By beholding the Word of God, by renewing your mind with it, you will become changed, creation of the Word takes place within you. The power that brought the worlds into existence is in The PROMISES of God! Every promise accepted by your will brings with it the power of The Infinite One; To transform you into HIS image and as you keep this up you go from glory to glory.

Every time you read the scriptures inspired by God, ask for the creative power within it to transform you. The same things I just mentioned apply to every promise you claim be it James1:5 for wisdom. Phillipians4:19 for your needs to be supplied that same creative energy is within those promises that created the World you live in. There is no less power in God's Word today than there was then. AMEN!

Alright so that's it from me... I'll see you on part 3.. so far in this module we have studied God's Love and now God's Integrity and we learnt:

- **God CAN'T lie**
- **He keeps His Word to His OWN Hurt**
- **God submits Himself to His own laws and binds Himself to them.** He does this for YOUR benefit, so that YOU can have every confidence in obeying Him.

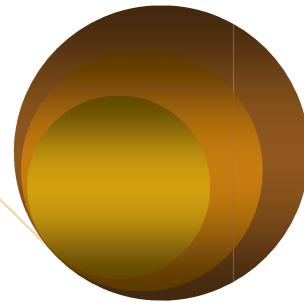
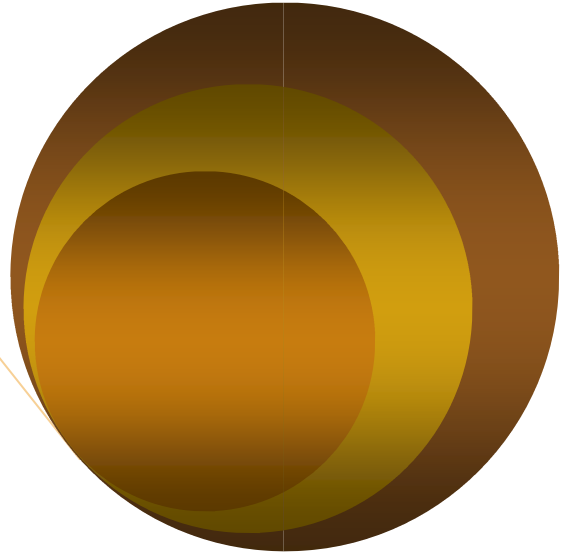
- Unless you claim His promise, He can't do anything, your request must be according to something HE said IS His will

And this is all essential to have you pray a prayer of faith. But it's not complete so next we will study God's impartiality in part 3. So you know without question God made every promise He made to you specifically as an individual.

Now I'm going to show you an interview, which contains some amazing facts about your brain functions and I think it will add to you your desire to study the Word of God and increase your confidence in taking God at His Word, an inspired writer once wrote, *"It is a law both of the intellectual and the spiritual nature that by beholding we become changed. The mind gradually adapts itself to the subjects upon which it is allowed to dwell. It becomes assimilated to that which it is accustomed to love and reverence."* So by constantly feeding your mind with God's Word you WILL become changed and as a man thinketh... so is He... Enjoy!

IMPARTIALITY

Hi this is Elliot... welcome to part 3 of 4 of Module 4: 100% Confidence in God's L.I.I.P.s
We have studied how we KNOW God Loves us and How He is faithful to make good on His Word 100% of the time.

Now we need to study how impartial God is... In order to pray a prayer OF FAITH you need to be certain of God's **Impartiality**. God doesn't have favourites, but YOU need to be certain of that, **if** you are to have faith that God will actually do anything for YOU specifically!

Well I've said, "God Doesn't Have Favourites" and He doesn't... He favours obedience! There is nothing God would do for Jesus that He wouldn't do for you...**if** YOU will do the SAME things Jesus did... that's one of the reasons Jesus came... to make God's blessings available to ALL no exceptions... and He also came to show you how YOU receive them!

So today we are going to find out where it says all this in the Bible! So you'll be so sure that when YOU pray God will answer YOU! And when anybody asks you'll be able prove from what God has had recorded in His Word that He is willing to do as much for you as He did for anybody else that holds Him at His Word!

Have you ever seen one of God's promises which you want fulfilled in your life. But you felt that for whatever reason, "God's not gonna do that for me! I'm nobody special..." ?

But yet you need God to do something, but you can't see how it will happen for YOU maybe because there is no possible visible way it can happen for you because YOUR circumstances are special, you don't know anybody who can or is even willing to help you. And you get frustrated because you don't know what you should do or what you should do to get God's intervention in your situation!

Well I have had that too **here's my story**, I didn't exactly believe God showed favouritism, but I could see, that some people's prayers seemed to get answered and yet I was still waiting for God to do something for me... and don't get me wrong, I WAS happy for them, but at times I felt like God was going to wait until everything was as worse as it could possibly be before He did anything to help me, (if He decided to do anything at all).

I knew God had His promises but I wasn't convinced that whatever He promised, that I saw fulfilled in someone else's life He would do for me to... I grew up thinking whatever God wants to happen WILL happen. I didn't think there was anything I could do to influence God's hand in my life, other than hope so and maybe if I beg God enough, I might convince Him to change His mind and do something. I didn't know that you could pray according to His will and He will answer.

Until eventually I started to actually grasp some understanding from what God Himself had to say and that was a relief compared with, being in the middle of a crossfire of random thoughts going on

between my ears. See I had, had impressions made on me and had been programmed to take what **other people** thought and said as gospel, because **a)** they were older than me or a person of authority who was respected by many or **b)** they just sounded like they knew what they were talking about, because they could quote some scriptures.

Here is my story finding **the solution...**

Ironically one thing I heard people say a lot was, that you should never take what **other people** say about God's Word without checking it out for yourself. But I had NO idea where to find certain scriptures, but from taking notes in sermons and Bible studies like this and cross referencing scriptures in my Bible I began to build up a decent knowledge of scriptures to KNOW what God REALLY thinks. And the conclusion I came to was, God does not have favourites He Favours obedience. So I thought Ok, I need to know what to be obedient to and obey it and His promises will be fulfilled in my life.

And in my studies I found there were 2 COMMON Myths Among Christians... *that the Devil uses to convince people that God ONLY favours certain people. And the rest of us get whatever crumbs He feels like throwing our way!*

The first myth is that God has a special blessing on the Jews which nobody else has or will ever have.

The second myth is that God only did certain things in the days of Jesus and they are not for our day.

And there are so many people who STILL believe this it's shocking! God doesn't care what race you are, what sex, or what class you and your family are from. He doesn't care what wrong you have done, in times past. And God certainly didn't reserve His goodness for people in times past nor has He decided not to bother with the people of today.

The TRUTH is... the only thing God favours is faith and obedience. And we ARE going to go into more detail dispelling these myths and go through what you need to do to experience God do **anything** He promised in His Word, because it's all for YOU! And He wants to give it to YOU and is willing to do so even if YOU are the only person to ask Him to in the history of mankind. And it is my prayer that at the end of this module YOU will be irrevocably convinced of that!

So here is a **Quick Presummary** of what we will study today to prove from what God HIMSELF has said that He indeed shows no favouritism to anyone. He will pour out His blessings on those who live lives of obedience...

Your gonna learn...

- **The Bible gives clear evidence** Dispelling The Myth of God's Favouritism
- Why God is not a respecter of persons, He is ONLY a respecter of OBEDIENCE...
- **That God created physical laws and spiritual laws...**
- God's Laws & Promises WORK consistently no matter who or what it is that is applying the law or claiming the promise...
- **You must study and Work** to come in perfect alignment with the laws...
- God's law/promises were (given in love) and must be (obeyed in love), in order for them to produce fruit...
- **EVERY promise claimed, which is met by the above conditions WILL be fulfilled INEVITABLY...**

- How YOU make all this practice with 4 steps? This is... **How YOU Get ALL benefits added onto you!**

You want to have ALL this hard wired in your neurological pathways and go over this over and over and form some of those white patches, with thoughts of God's impartiality and the truth about what it is He requires to fulfill His promises to YOU!

And the reason why is because when you do this, what you'll find is, you will experience... you gain power over ANY of the enemies devices sent to discourage you. He will have a hard challenge convincing you God doesn't want to perform for **YOU** personally, EVERY promise He ever made to mankind in **YOUR** life! (in fact He'd be much better off trying to convince you that, a baboon would make a great housekeeper, than ever convincing you God's promises which you claim won't come to pass for YOU).

Not only that but you will notice you will have acquired a positive contagious influence on others when encouraging them that God is willing to perform His promises for them. You will be able to achieve great levels of faith and confidence, once you know you are living in obedience to God's requirements and because of this you WILL experience God's promises come off the page of your Bible to being visible in your life!

If you don't burn these concepts in your mind, you'll miss out on all this. The devil will have every success at discouraging you, instead having a positive influence on the lives of others, their negativity will rub off on you and your faith will fail and you both lose out on achieving the great levels of confidence that God IS willing to extend His arms of mercy to you! And you will live a life of hit and miss when it comes to experiencing the promises of God fulfilled in your life.

All that can be prevented when you, fully grasp the vital information in this video. **Anybody** that does this and keeps it up will succeed with this... What I'm about to share with you is very simple and will move you from ambivalent doubt to unshakable confidence that God **will** fulfill His promises when YOU ask Him to, EVERY time you meet His requirements.

Ok so without further ado... Let's get the confidence we need from God's Word, to turn our puny faith, into WARRIOR status that will make demons tremble when they see you are a friend of Jesus...

Okay so here's the deal...

Christ pledged Himself to be EVERYONE'S substitute for paying their penalty for violating sin, including your penalty; and He neglects nobody who will accept what He has done for them and co-operate with Him. All God's promises require to be fulfilled in YOUR life is obedience! And Christ always offers HIS inexhaustible merits of obedience and applies them to YOUR sincere humble prayers and as they ascend to the throne of God; Your prayers are made into sweet incense by the application of His merits.

God is not a respecter of person's He is ONLY a respecter of OBEDIENCE... The best way to explain this is to look at how laws work. Laws are Laws... **God created physical laws and spiritual laws. And they both were set by His Word.**

"...the heavens and the earth, which ARE NOW, **by the SAME word are KEPT in store,**" 2Peter3:7.

God is "...**upholding all things by the word of his power**" Hebrews1:3. Both His Physical laws AND Spiritual Laws... YOU can SEE that physical laws are STILL being upheld By The Words Spoken by the lips of God. Gravity STILL works TODAY! Well His spiritual laws are **NO** different. So unless you happen to be floating around wherever you are right now, then you have evidence God's laws work for you. Well His spiritual law is NO different.

So When God says in James1:5-6, "*If any of you lack wisdom*, let him **ask of God**, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; **and it shall be given** him. But let him *ask in faith, nothing wavering.*"

That is a spiritual law, YOU ask in faith, you receive it! In fact it's deeper than law it's a covenant a blood covenant at that. And that covenant entitles you to constitutional rights of The Bible, that you as a joint heir with Jesus a citizen of the Kingdom of Heaven have every right to stake your claim.

So "Forget NOT all His Benefits" You are the beneficeary to who those benefits are extended. But the constitution demands, that YOU must demand them **and be in obedience** to the constitution and THAT through the merits of Jesus Christ entitles YOU and every other citizen of the Kingdom of Heaven to every promise you claim. God's promises are spiritual laws which must be fulfilled. This is why God wants you to study His Word to KNOW what you are entitled to. "The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may KNOW what is the hope of his calling, AND what the riches of the glory of his **inheritance** in the saints" Ephesians1:17

You must study and Work to come in perfect alignment with the laws.

Actively look through The Word for what you want to benefit from and simply, apply it, obey it, no matter what, stay consistent without wavering in your faith. "...though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry." (Habakkuk2:3) "*after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.*" (Hebrews10:36)

Laws work **consistently** no matter who or what it is that is applying the law. Like gravity it doesn't care if you are, rich, poor, fat, slim, beautiful or ugly, red or yellow, black or white it doesn't even care if you're a cat. It only cares if you are lighter than air. If you are heavier than air, the law of gravity dictates, you get pulled towards the centre of earth.

Unless you apply a law called the law of lift which supersedes gravity which makes objects heavier than air defy gravity, but that's because the object heavier than air is in actual fact now in obedience to the law of lift. So it will lift up. The law of sickness is in operation, but if you comply with the laws governing health, you become healthy.

Which ever laws YOU are in obedience to, affect the circumstances YOU manifest in your life. Apply this to any law/promise in The Bible, if it is says, do this and this will happen, DO IT and WATCH it come to pass. The same way gravity works **all** the time for ANYone the laws of the kingdom of God work **all** the time for ANYone. Natural law and spiritual laws work the same way, because they were both set in place by the SAME person!

If you are in obedience to the laws of sin contradicting those of The Kingdom expect the manifestation from your actions. unless you are in COMPLETE obedience to the laws of The Kingdom obeying no other law, then you will struggle with the manifestation of God's promises...

So since Law is no respecter of persons, I would just like to add a word of warning. Don't make the mistake of being so arrogant to think Spiritual Law aka "The Word of God" won't work for you. To say that means you are above the law (and since God made the laws) to say that would mean you are above God. I'm sure you're intelligent enough to know better than that.

Applying a law and thinking it won't work for you, when every person in mankind who did it before and has had it work for them, is kind of like; being in a situation where you are about to jump off a driving board. You've seen people jumping off and all WITHOUT exception, have gone down into the



water and yet you con yourself into thinking that when you jump off that board, "I don't think gravity is gonna work for me, I think I'm gonna end up floating and get stuck suspended in the air." That is ridiculous!!!

Just DO whatever The Word says and trust it will come to pass, you have **GOD's** Word, "Be not deceived God is not mocked for whatsoever a man soweth that shall he also reap." (Galatians6:7)

James1:22-25 has some brilliant advice to follow, if you wanna see God's Word work for you, it says "...be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. *(that's for those thinking what they heard is going to work, just by hearing it)*

For if any be a hearer of the word, **and not a doer**, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: (they didn't have mirrors in those days, but if they did, James would have said mirror)

For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was." (So the man looked in the mirror and forgot what he looked like. If you read The Word and don't do it, it's almost like you didn't read it at all, it has no significance until you do it.)

Verse 25 "But whoso looketh into the perfect law of **liberty**, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, **this man SHALL BE BLESSED** in his deed."

Find The Word, Do the Word and Stay in Faith *and you automatically qualify to; REAP THE BENEFITS!!!*

There are 2 things to ALWAYS bare in mind about God's Laws/Promises... When the RIGHT conditions are met they work 1) EVERY**time** for 2) EVERY**one**

"Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise." Hebrews10:35-36

Therefore the "RIGHT" condition is "OBEDIENCE" to whatever the promise requires, as faith WITHOUT WORKS is Dead!

Faith ITSELF is a law/condition NEEDED to please God. And faith works BY "love". Therefore your obedient works of faith MUST be "*Motivated BY Love*" "*love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment.*

And the **second** is like unto it, Thou shalt *love thy neighbour as thyself*.

On these two commandments **hang ALL the law**" Matthew 22:37-40

God's law/promises were (given in love) and must be (obeyed in love), in order for them to produce fruit.

Love is not self seeking (1Corinthians 13) Jesus said, "...I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me." John 5:30 "Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether he be bond or free." Ephesians 6:8 So whoever you are whatever seed you sow without the motive of expecting return. You reap a harvest you weren't expecting. "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap." Galatians 6:7

EVERY promise claimed, which is met by the above conditions WILL be fulfilled INEVITABLY, sponsored by the merits of JESUS CHRIST.

"...faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. ...by the word of God... things which are seen were not made of things which do appear." Hebrews 11:1-3

"we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal." 2Corinthians 4:18

The Just Shall LIVE By OBEDIENCE LOVE & Faith

The Bottom line is: Find The Word, Do the Word and Stay in Faith and you automatically qualify to; REAP THE BENEFITS!!!

God is no respecter of persons He is a respecter of obedience.

Now we are talking about impartiality When God says something; It IS Law. Therefore His promises ARE laws. Now God is His Word and The Word is God. Therefore if His Word is no respecter of persons HE is no respecter of persons and when you claim His promise. He is faithful to hasten His Word to perform it. (Jeremiah 1:12)

"Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is **no variableness, neither shadow of turning.**" James 1:17

God sees YOU as an individual. He is His Word and He will not break His covenant or alter anything He has said, there is no variableness to His Promises, neither the slightest chance of His promises coming to pass for one person and not another, providing His conditions are met.

You can rest assured God will make good on His Word to YOU personally simply because God **wants** to do it for you. He has even gone as far as making promises... Knowing once He makes His promise, He is bound to His Word, He can't lie. So by that fact of truth. Him being No respecter of persons forces Him (by bondage to His Word) into a position of OBLIGATION. So even if He didn't want to (which He Does) but even if He didn't, He has to... because of what HE said in His Word, that He is no respecter of persons.

He can't go back on His Word. He doesn't want to either, He wants to perform what He says, more than you want Him to do it. Why else would He say, "forgot not ALL His benefits" knowing all the many promises He made? Because He wants YOU to **claim** them so He can do them in YOUR life. Because His promises claimed by you serve His purpose and fulfill HIS dreams. That's why He will hasten His Word to perform it for YOU. (Jeremiah1:12).

You have to think of The Word of God as a personal promise to you personally as if you were the only human being on the face of earth. God's Word is written directly to you and He was thinking of you when He had it recorded. Put your name in the promises.



"...the LORD WILL give grace and glory: **no good thing** will he withhold from them that walk uprightly."

Psalms84:11

So all you have left to do is, "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened

unto you:

For EVERY one that asketh **receiveth**; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone?

Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?" Matthew7:7-11

God Shows No Favouritism... He doesn't love anybody else more than He loves you, not even Jesus. Yes you heard me correctly. **God loves you JUST AS MUCH as He loves Jesus.** In John17:23 Jesus prayed, "...that the world may know that thou (GOD) hast sent me, and hast loved them, **as thou hast loved me.**" If God loves you as He has loved Jesus; then *there is no way*, He will do something for one person and not do it for you, if He loves you just as much as Jesus.

God doesn't say, I'm going to fulfill this promise to this group of people only and that promise to another. Or I'll bless him or give wisdom to her and then say to someone else, sorry I'm not gonna do it for you, I don't really like you. God isn't like man. God's love isn't based on conditions.

Dispelling The Myth of God's Favouritism

If you ever thought, that the promises of God were just for the Jews. Oh boy we are going to BLAST that lie of the devil into oblivion with the Word of God... I've heard too many people say to me, "Elliot the Jews are so blessed they are God's special people... and I'm a gentile no-one important to God."

Well I'm tired of hearing it, because if you think God shows favouritism, one you're calling God unjust, two a liar and third you are allowing the devil to steal from you, who seeks who "He MAY devour" well if YOU think God shows favouritism, you are the one the devil "may devour" because you won't have

faith that God is impartial and willing to fulfill His promises to **anyone** who meets His requirements, not a special group of people. You can belong to a special group of people, yet live in disobedience as the Israelites did and eventually God's favour is withdrawn and other nations were allowed to prevail over them. God is not a repector of persons He is a respector of obedience.

Now I don't want the devil to steal from you, so I've collected an arsenal of scriptures from the Word of God, ready to fire at any unbelief that tries to exalt itself against God, that will convince you, YOU are as special to God as Jesus Himself and He favours nobody above you.

See God did begin His work with a special group of people but AFTER Christ shed His blood for YOU The Bible gives clear evidence that God has now taken the privileges He gave to the Jews and made them available to every person who will accept the merits of His Son. The Bible seems to have different ideas to the ones popularly held by foolish traditions of man, let's remember that "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:" 2Timothy3:16.



The scripture TELLS us CLEARLY God shows no favouritism, He only favours faith and obedience. If you are in Christ He has made you "joint heir" WITH Christ and you were "BLESSED **with** Abraham" but where does it say all that? Glad you asked, let me show you.

"...the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, **In thee** shall all nations be **blessed**." Galatians 3:8

"Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: That the blessing OF Abraham might come on the Gentiles (non-Jews) through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith." Galatians3:13-14

"18For if the inheritance be of the law, it is no more of promise: but God gave it to Abraham by promise.

22 But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that **the promise by faith** of Jesus Christ **might be given to them that believe**." Galatians3:18,22

"For ye are all the children of God **by faith in Christ Jesus**. ²⁷For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. ²⁸There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise." Galatians3:26-29

"So then they which be of faith are **blessed WITH faithful Abraham**." Galatians 3:9

The Word faithful there is very significant because according to first verse in Galatians4

"...the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;" Galatians4:1 YOU are blessed with Abraham when you believe and are faithful to keep God's Word.

"God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. Wherefore you art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ." Galatians4:6-7

"Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise." Galatians4:28

"The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and **joint-heirs with Christ**; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together." Romans8:16-17

God "Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things..." Hebrews1:2.

If Jesus is heir of all things, and you are JOINT-heir with Jesus YOU are heirs of all things. Jesus prayed especially that we would be granted this great honour in John17:24, "I will that they also, whom Thou hast given Me, be with Me where I am." The Father of the prodigal son said to His other son who felt, his prodigal brother was being treated better than he was; "...Son, thou art ever with me, and **all that I have is thine.**" Luke 15:31.

Male Female, red yellow black white, rich poor, slim fat, ugly beautiful... We are ALL under the same covenant. "Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed **shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.**" (Acts3:25)

"That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: **But now** in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ." (Ephesians2:12-13)



So now you should KNOW what God says to one He says to all (Mark13:37)

"There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus." Galatians3:28

"God is no respecter of persons" Acts10:34

"there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him." Romans10:12

Oh and if you ever thought, that the promises of God were just for a certain time and not now. Here is one scripture, that I know will make you reconsider. By the way all the scriptures I mentioned before don't just apply to racial boundaries, they also cover time frame from the beginning of time to now. Here's the scripture Ecclesiastes7:10, "Say not thou, What is the cause that the former days were better than these? for thou dost not enquire wisely concerning this."

If anything "these" days are better than former days, check this out Hebrews8:6 says, "But now hath he (Jesus) obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a **better covenant**, which was established upon **better promises**."

"Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah...He asked life of thee, and thou gavest it him, even length of days for ever and ever... For thou hast made him most blessed for ever." Psalm21:2,4,6.

Ok So Now you know God is no respecter of anyone, no matter who they are, where they are from, God shows no favouritism to any. All His promises are available to all, What Do You Do? How Can You Get His promises fulfilled in your life?

I've said it several times... God is no respecter of person's He is a respecter of obedience, motivated by love. But How do YOU make this practice? This is... **How YOU Get ALL benefits added onto you!**



"...forget not all his benefits" Psalm103:2 or promises. Question can you forget something you have never known, in the first place? No... so you have to begin by Studying to KNOW what His benefits or promises are... This is why I have given you "God's Artillery of Promises"

Because Jesus said, "...seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things (benefits & promises) shall be added unto you." Matthew6:33

Psalms119:172 says, "...all thy commandments are righteousness." Commandments are righteousness. Jesus said, Seek **FIRST** His Kingdom (in other words seek FIRST to KNOW How His kingdom is governed...) and His righteousness, His commandments are righteousness, so seek His commandments and DO them! In doing this you are seeking the Kingdom of God and as you obey, His commandments which you came to know from FIRST seeking the Kingdom of God, all the benefits from the promises you are obeying will be added unto you!

"...the LORD will give grace and glory: **no good thing will he withhold from them that WALK uprightly.**" Psalm84:11

Don't make the mistake of thinking because you have heard something once that you have mastered it. If you're not applying it, then you obviously don't get it yet. So continue to Read & Review the checklist and the syllabus statement everyday for 30days morning and evening.

Look into God's Artillery of Promises and see what the promise is and the command accompanying it and ask God to show you what you need to do and ask Him to help you to obey in love and stay faithful in applying each principle you learn.

- 1) Read & Review The "Checklist" and "The Syllabus Statement" morning and evening for at least 30 days!
- 2) Seek to Know God's Promises & Commands in "God's Artillery of Promises"
- 3) Ask God to show you what you need to do to "obey Him in Love" and "Stay Faithful"

- 4) Be patient after you have done the will of God you might receive the promise. Watch as God hastens to perform HIS Word.

This is the most reliable way the Bible teaches how you get consistent results. When you do those 4 things consistently, you WILL gain power over ANY of the enemy's devices sent to discourage you. He will have a hard challenge convincing you God's promises which you claim won't come to pass for YOU! Because you KNOW you are on the right path! "No weapon formed against you shall prosper" Isaiah54:17

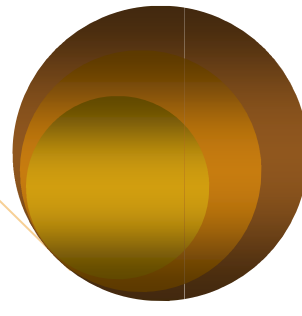
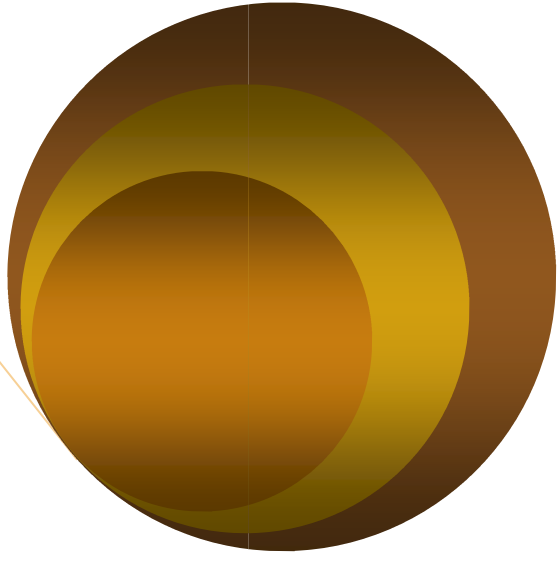

So He will either try to present circumstances to prevent you from starting and/or being consistent with these 4 action steps and if you are taking them consistently, He will make it look like they aren't bearing any fruit.

But I can promise you that these 4 steps will bear fruit, because of what God said in Isaiah1:19 that, "if you are willing and obedient you shall eat the good of the Land" Because Isaiah55:11 says, "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it."

"Be not deceived whatever a man soweth that shall He also reap." Galatians6:7 Whatever seeds of obedience you sow in Love you WILL reap, stay faithful!

"...it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments... all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God." Deuteronomy28:1-2

PROMISES

Is any in need among you? “...pray ...in the name of the Lord: the prayer of faith ...The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.” James5:14-16

In order to pray a prayer OF FAITH you need to be certain... God **loves** YOU and WANTS to give you the desire of your heart, certain of how he WANTS to bless you MORE than YOU want to be blessed...

In order to pray a prayer OF FAITH you need to be certain of God's **Integrity**... God holds His Word it ABOVE His own name (Psalm138:2)! He can't lie therefore what He promises WILL be done.

In order to pray a prayer OF FAITH you need to be certain of God's **Impartiality** God doesn't have favourites, He favours obedience. There is no-thing God would do for Jesus that He wouldn't do for you...

When you understand those three things and master believing it **without doubt** your faith explodes exponentially into another dimension and any promise God made is possible.

“...What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them” Mark11:24

So, “...forget not all His benefits” Psalms103:2 (Have a look in “God's Artillery of Promises to YOU”) We have studied how much God wants to bless you and how much of a person of INTEGRITY HE is... So when God says, “I promise you this, if you will do that...” He WILL see to it that His Promise is fulfilled to you!

And God has PROMISED YOU... He WILL supply needs, protection, wisdom, healing, His Holy Spirit, “the fruit of the spirit in your character” and victory overcoming sin.

Ask and you SHALL receive. God Answers YES YES YES! “For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.” (2Corinthians1:20) God gets glory when His promises are fulfilled in us!

“Ye have not because you ask not.” James4:2

"...this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him." 1John5:14-15

"...What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them" Mark11:24

"And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight." 1John3:22

"And it SHALL come to pass... the LORD **will** give you, according as he hath **promised**, that ye shall keep this service." Exodus 12:25

"For thus saith the LORD; ...I bring upon them all the good that I have **promised** them." Jeremiah 32:42

"Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I **will perform** that good thing which I have **promised**..." Jeremiah 33:14

"For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the **will** of God, ye might receive the **promise**." Hebrews 10:36

You need to live your life like Abraham "...being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform." Romans 4:21

Ask and you will receive..., "EVERY good gift and EVERY perfect gift... **from the Father** of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning." James1:17.

Every good and perfect gift is from above and comes from the Father of lights. What does it mean by Father of lights, well Jesus said we are the children OF light. ("While ye have light, **believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light**..." John12:36, "...now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light" Ephesians5:8. You one of "the lights" that "The Father of Lights" is Father of! And your Father gives good and perfect gifts.

In fact He loves you **SO MUCH** that, "He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?" (Romans8:32)



How much??? Do you have to love someone to let the closest person to you, whom you love so dearly, be beaten brutally and crucified to die; just to save someone else, who doesn't even deserve it or even show appreciation for it? That takes love beyond the ability you and I have to even begin to comprehend it.

You can't even fathom that degree of love!!! Think about it for a moment? Would you do that for people who were nothing more than wretched, filthy sinners?

And yet despite all that you are so loving, you say to those same wicked people, "I am going to forgive you and make you righteous and take you home to live with me."

That takes a lot of love!!! I'm sorry but knowing this, you would fail miserably in an attempt to convince me, that if God was willing to give the most precious thing TO Him to be sacrificed in the most inhumane way just for ME... that He wouldn't also with that also freely give me ALL things...

If He was willing to GIVE YOU **the most valuable thing** to HIM... Don't you think, everything else pales in comparison? If He gave His ONLY son... SURELY He will freely give you all things, without a problem... If He gave His Son, trust me He will give anything.

"...the LORD WILL give grace and glory: **no good thing** will he withhold from them that walk uprightly." Psalm84:11

So all you have left to do is, "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For EVERY one that asketh **receiveth**; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? God's Promises that He CAN'T Let You Down...

"For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us." (2Corinthians1:20)

David Once cried out, "Lord, how are they increased that trouble me! Many are they that rise up against me. Many there be which say of my soul, There is no help for him in God. Selah. But thou, O

LORD, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head." Psalm3:1-3

"...the LORD WILL give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly." Psalm84:11

King David said, "I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread." Psalm37:25

"The just shall live by faith..." (Hebrews10:38) "Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you WILL PERFORM it until the day of Jesus Christ:" Phillippians1:6

So keep, "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God." Hebrews 12:2

"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28

God shows no favouritism, what others have seen happen for them you can see happen for you. God has made it clear, He loves us ALL and He loves ALL equally so it is up to you, to meet the criteria He has established; that those who see His goodness meet. And they are those who are willing and obedient (Isaiah 1:19) and have patience. It is they who after they have done the will of God receive the promise. (Hebrews 10:36)

It is they who eat the good of the land (Isaiah 1:19) and see the goodness of God in the land of the living (Psalm 27:13).

YES the promises of God are available to all. But they are not automatic, once they are claimed they have to be provoked into action by *consistent obedience* and *unwavering faith*.

There are 3 Steps to Seeing Blessings Overtake You and Have ALL THINGS ADDED Unto You... The Good News is, You Only Have To do 2 God does the last one...

#1) You have to seek The Word, to find out what it says...

#2) Obey it...

#3) Watch blessings come on you and overtake you and experience ALL THINGS being ADDED unto you...

You only have the first 2 parts to do and God does the rest, How simple is that?

Do I have Scripture to prove this is true? **ABSOLUTLEY**... You will see there are parts in blue (THIS IS YOUR PART) and the parts in red are God's part.

Matthew 6:33 says, "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."

Deuteronomy 28:1-2 says, "And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God."

Meditate on these scriptures. Renew your mind with them often, I guarantee your faith will be rock solid, unshakable. And you will be living in the manifestation of the promises God made!

Just know **FIRST** God loves you...

SECOND He CAN'T compromise on His Word...

THIRD He shows no favouritism, He loves YOU *as much* as He loves JESUS...

And when you are FULLY persuaded of those three things... You will see **FOURTH** you can believe and be convinced of anything God promised. And with your consistent obedience and unwavering faith. You WILL experience the MANIFESTATION of whatever His promise is...

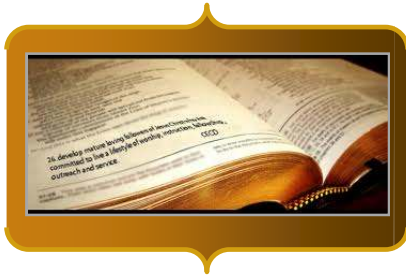
Isaiah8:20 says, "To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them."

If you're not praying according to God's Word you're not praying! Going to God demanding His Will Be done ON EARTH as it is in Heaven... Saying, "Lord You promised" is the most powerful thing you can say! As a citizen of the Kingdom of Heaven as a Child of the King as joint heir with Jesus, you can place your demand on the promises of God and they MUST by LAW be fulfilled! "Thus saith the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me... concerning the work of my hands command **ye me**." Isaiah45:11

YOU have to place the command for your Rights to be fulfilled!

"You have not BECAUSE **YOU** ask not..." James4:2. "...the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him..."

2Chronicles16:9 God has to look for someone who will give Him permission, by surrendering of their will and the submission of their requests according to His Will, for Him to have legal right to get involved in human affairs. "The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's: **but the earth hath he given to the children of men.**" Psalm115:16



Jesus said, "I will give unto **thee** the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and **whatsoever thou** shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and **whatsoever thou** shalt loose on earth shall be

loosed in heaven." Matthew16:19

God "...is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, **according to the power that worketh in us**" Ephesians3:20 "...According to YOUR faith **be it** unto you." Matthew9:29

So God says, "Command ye me" You command me, according to my promises so I can do my will in this earth! How do you command? You ask! "ask and IT (whatever it IS) **shall** be given unto you" matthew7:7

"...this is the **confidence that we have** in him, that, if we ask **any** thing according to his will... we know that he hear us, **whatsoever we ask**, we KNOW that we have the petitions that we desired of him." 1John5:14-15

The government officials of heaven (His angels) will employ every effort to meet your humble request, according to His Promises. "Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?" Hebrews1:14 "Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto **the voice of his word.**" Psalm103:20

So my suggestion NOW is the same as earlier... **Find** The Word and **Do** The Word and **WATCH** God Perform!!!



“This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.”

Joshua1:8

“Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper” Psalm1:1-3

King David said, “I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law is within my heart.” Psalm40:8

“I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.” Psalm119:16

“And I will delight myself in thy commandments, which I have loved.” Psalm119:47

“The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.

The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and **in keeping of them** there is **GREAT REWARD.**” Psalm19:7-11.

Look what Proverbs 8 has to say, “Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right things.

... They are all plain to him that understandeth, and right to them that find knowledge. Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold. For wisdom is better than rubies;

and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it. I wisdom dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions.

... Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength. By me kings reign, and princes decree justice. By me princes rule, and nobles, even all the judges of the earth. I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me. Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness. My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver. **I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment: That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.**

...Now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children: for blessed are they that keep my ways. Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not. Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors. For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD." Proverbs8:6,9-12,14-21,32-35

"My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments: For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee. Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:" Proverbs3:1-3

I therefore encourage you to BE Determined to Live a life of obedience,

"And it SHALL come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day... all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God."

Deuteronomy28:1-2 "If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land." Isaiah1:19

"Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that **favour MY righteous cause**: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant" Psalm35:27 "Beloved,

I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." 3John2.



"And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, **BECAUSE we KEEP his commandments**, and do **those things that are pleasing** in his sight." (*And by the way just so you know it continues*) "...THIS is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another..." **1John3:22-23**

"For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the **will** of God, ye might receive the **promise**." Hebrews10:36

"For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister." Hebrews6:10

"Delight thyself also in the LORD: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart" Psalm37:4.

Delight yourself in the Lord and Encourage yourself In the Lord... Encourage yourself in His Word (which is all you have) and thankfully a living God who Honours it.

"David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him... but David encouraged himself in the **LORD** his God." 1Samuel30:6

"Thou wilt keep him in perfect **peace**, whose **mind** is **stayed** on thee: because he trusteth in thee." Isaiah26:3 and since according to John1:1 God is also the Word. Our mind will be kept in perfect peace, when it stays focused on what God has promised, rather than what's going on around us.

God promises in Hebrews13:5, "I will **never** leave thee, nor forsake thee." David said, "I have been young, and now am old; yet have I **not** seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread." Psalm37:25. God gives us His Promise "...**bread shall** be given him; his waters **shall** be **sure**." Isaiah33:16. "He shall supply all your need according to HIS riches in glory..." Phil4:19. David said, "I had fainted, unless I had **believed** to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living." Psalm27:13. You must believe.

"...without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God **must believe** that he is, **and** that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." Hebrews11:6

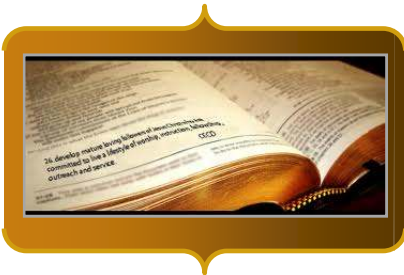

So they escort you to heaven! And there He is the King of Kings on His throne and you fall on your face in awe and reverence Him!

Then He picks you up and you notice He has a hand behind His back and as He talks to you, He gives you a bit of a tour of heaven and tells you this will one day be your home, if you will remain faithful. But tell my people I'm coming and be ready for me, when I come, now I know you will have need of many things to help you in your mission...



Then He looks you square in the eyes and says, in the most reassuring sincere tone of voice; "Any time you need anything, ANYthing at all... no matter how big or small, Call me and I will

give whatsoever you ask, there's a catch though..."

And He reaches behind His back and pulls out the most magnificent book you have ever seen and He continues, "I've written this book for you personally, it tells you everything I'm willing to do for you... Anything you ask me, must be according to what is written in this book. Whatever you ask in accordance with this, I WILL personally see to it that it is done... NOW each one of these promises, are for you personally, I have looked into your future and I already know EXACTLY when you will need each one of these promises... and (as He points to this ENORMOUS golden warehouse) He says I have already taken the liberty of preparing every provision, so that everyone of the promises you claim will be fulfilled.

And to receive them all you need to do it meet my requirements, in the instructions you will read and claim these promises and they will be yours!"

Then He hands you the magnificent book and He says, "Take this back to earth with you". Then He says, "Now before you go, I want to show you one last thing" and He shows you, a golden censer and you feel a tremendous heat comes out of it and it is one of the most delightful smells you have ever smelt. Then you ask, "What is that?" He says, "These are the fervent prayers of the righteous which avail MUCH... when YOU make your humble fervent requests according to these promises I've given you, in this book, this is how they will come before me, they are mingled with the merits of Jesus that's the fragrance you are smelling, your petitions in HIS name as you will read in John 16:23 of this book I've given you will come before my face and to my ears and I will grant your requests... according to my will and timing." And then you are escorted back to earth, with the book He gave you, your Bible..."

I want you to see yourself in those promises as if that story just happened, when you go into "God's Artillery of Promises for You" as you open up your Bible, remember this story! Something similar happened to John The Revelator to show you what happens when you pray, so that you KNOW

YOUR Prayers ACTUALLY Reach The Throne of Heaven... Also REMEMBER When you Pray YOU are Talking to a REAL person:

John Records, "And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals. And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints." **Revelation 5:1,8.**

"And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne.⁴ And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand" **Revelation 8:3-4.**

When I pray I believe I'm actually talking to someone and that person is listening and willing to do as I ask... I'm talking to a real tangible person, an actual person. And I'm talking to a real person who has vast resources to whom ALL things are possible and nothing is too hard for, and this person has promised me whatsoever I ask if I believe it, he will give it and I will have whatsoever I ask. A person who always honours word. Whose word never fails.

That's the type of person YOU are talking to and it is a REAL person. ALWAYS bare that in mind when praying.

You know it came to mind... when ex Devil worshippers, that came out of darkness, into light give their testimonies, they often become people of GREAT faith. And it's because they used to pray or do things to invoke demonic activity, physical stuff would happen right in front of their eyes.

So they come into the light KNOWING that supernatural forces are real working forces, and their activity can be somewhat directed by us and our faith in them good and evil. So when these people come out of darkness, into light. They know since the evil they dealt with is real... God is not imaginary He is a real tangible being! And they know that when they pray they are talking to God and He hears and acts, in fact before they even called. "According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue" 2Peter1:3

So when they make requests, they know things will happen and that the things they see now are merely temporary and that the Just LIVE by faith. Faith begins where the will of God is KNOWN. And what they ask for WILL be given. When you pray encourage yourself in the Lord about God's WILLINGNESS, to perform His Word, When you claim His promise say, "Lord I know you are willing..." and thank God as though what you requested is done already!

Your Prayers reach God's throne and He ANSWERS YOUR Requests:

David said, "In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my God: **he heard my voice out of his temple**, and my cry came before him, even into his ears.

He brought me forth also into a large place; **he delivered me, BECAUSE** *he delighted in me.* **The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness;** according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me. For I have kept the ways of the LORD, and have not wickedly departed from my God.

For all his judgments were before me, and I did not put away his statutes from me. I was also upright before him, and I kept myself from mine iniquity. Therefore hath the LORD recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eyesight.

With the merciful thou wilt shew thyself merciful; with an upright man thou wilt shew thyself upright; With the pure thou wilt shew thyself pure; and with the froward thou wilt shew thyself froward.

For thou wilt save the afflicted people; but wilt bring down high looks. For thou wilt light my candle: the LORD my God will enlighten my darkness.

For by thee I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall.

As for God, **his way is perfect:** the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him. For who is God save the LORD? Or who is a rock save our God? It is **God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect.**" Psalm18:6,19-32

"We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: **the LORD fulfil ALL thy petitions.** Now know I that the LORD saveth his anointed; he **will** hear him from his holy heaven with the saving strength of his right hand." Psalm20:5-6.

("Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.

But know that the LORD hath set apart him that is godly for himself: **the LORD will hear when I call unto him.** ⁴Stand in awe, and sin not: *commune with your own heart upon your bed*, AND BE STILL. Selah. Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD." Psalm4:1,3-5,

"My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up." Psalm5:3,

"The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer." Psalm6:9)

Remember you have Jesus interceding for you in Heaven. He has become your advocate. He lifts up those who believe in Him and He has placed a treasure house of blessings at your demand. It's only the merit and righteousness of Christ that will avail anything, but this is placed on credit to your account! So **WHENEVER** you pray Jesus places His merit in the golden censer to offer up with your prayers, so that the prayers of His joint-heirs may be mingled with the fragrant merit of Christ as they ascend before your Father, in the cloud of incense!

And Because of this you can call upon God at any moment and He answers, "I AM Here" Your Daddy who loves you more than you can even begin to understand hears everyone of your HUMBLE prayers. Your voice of supplication unites with the voice of Jesus your advocate, who The Father ALWAYS hears! Therefore let your prayers continually ascend to God!

Jesus has given you HIS name to use. "...ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you: For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God." John16:26-27

So use His name and it will be like your passport to the heart of The Father and it grants you access to all the riches of His grace! Amen...
