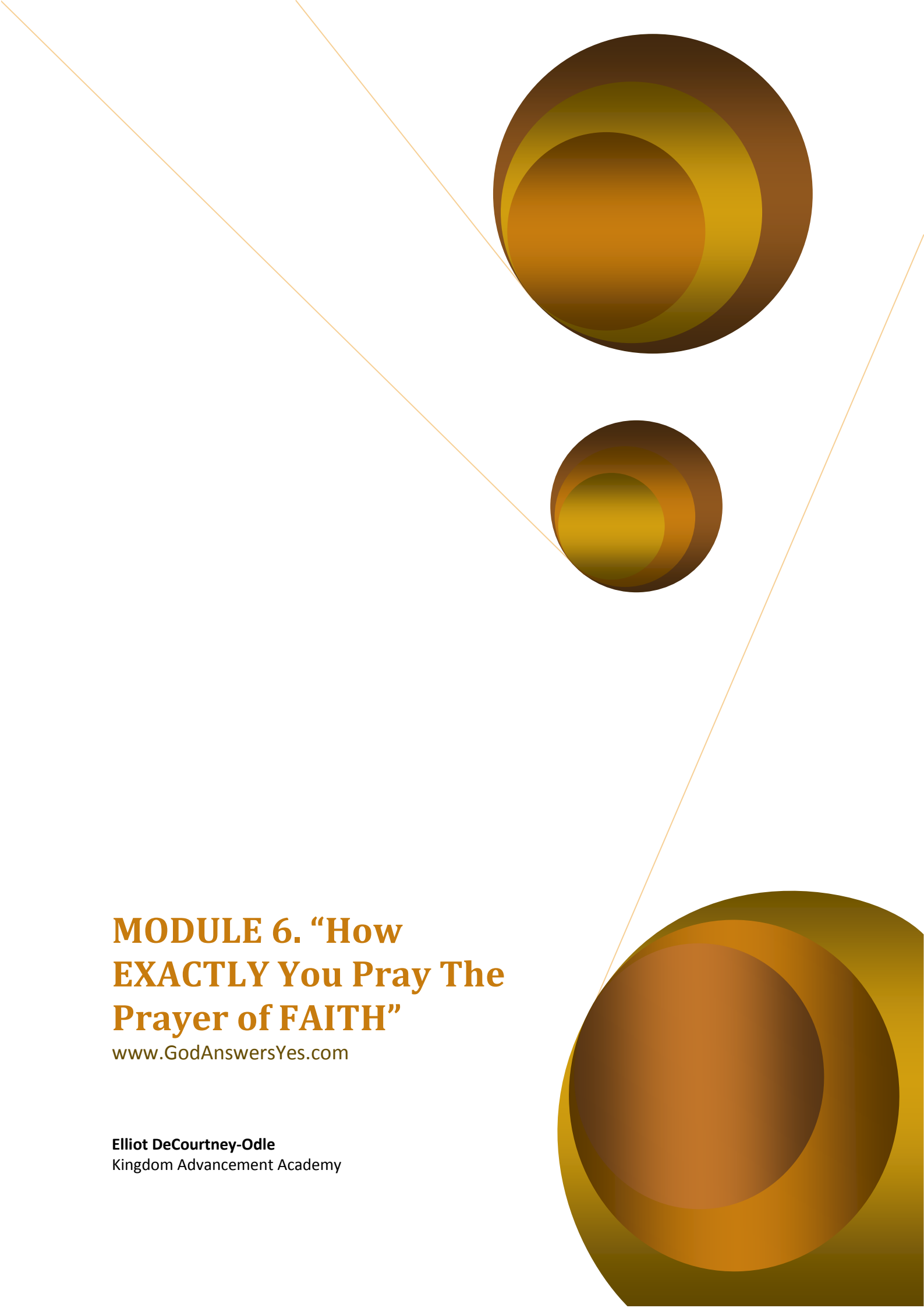

Module6: How EXACTLY You Pray The Prayer of Faith

Why???

"...without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." **Hebrews11:6**

"...the **prayer** OF **FAITH** shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up..." **James5:15**

(In the context we are talking about the prayer of faith is the only type of prayer which gets results.)

What - God says (what to do | what NOT to do)

Faith BEGINS Where the Will of God Is KNOWN!

The **WHY** of God's Will Known.

"...be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;" **Colossians1:9-10**

The key to praying the prayer of FAITH is to be in a state of mind WHEN you are making your request. And that state of mind is to be in expectation that you WILL receive your request! That's why you need to KNOW God's will.

You wanna go by "Thus saith the Lord" so when you pray you can say... God according to YOUR will/word, you said you'd do this! Your faith in God's Word and Jesus' name, are the only tools you have which carry any weight as far as heaven is concerned.

When you can say, "God YOU Said!!!" It moves heaven.

It's Like going for welfare you meet certain qualifications the government guarantees you get what you ask for according to rules they set. Similar with the government in the kingdom of heaven.

Once you KNOW what God's will actually says and you meet it's requirements for it to be fulfilled, "then you are in a position to make demands for His will to be fulfilled" and EXPECT them to happen!

I'll give you an example, so you know I'm NOT just making this up:

PROBLEM

"...the children of Moab, and the children of Ammon, and with them other beside the Ammonites, came against Jehoshaphat to battle. ²Then there came some that told Jehoshaphat, saying, There cometh a great multitude against thee from beyond the sea on this side Syria; and, behold, they be in Hazazontamar, which is Engedi." **2Chronicles20:1-2**

REMINDING GOD OF HIS PROMISE

³And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah. ⁴And Judah gathered themselves together, to ask help of the LORD: even out of all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD.

⁵And Jehoshaphat stood in the congregation of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD, before the new court, ⁶And said, O LORD God of our fathers, art not thou God in heaven? and rulest not thou over all the kingdoms of the heathen? and in thine hand is there not power and might, so that none is able to withstand thee?

⁷Art not thou our God, who didst drive out the inhabitants of this land before thy people Israel, and gavest it to the seed of Abraham thy friend **FOR EVER?**" **2Chronicles20:3-7**

"...how they (the moabites & ammonites) reward us, to come to cast us out of thy possession, which thou hast given US to inherit." (He reminds God of His promise again) **2Chronicles20:11**

DEMAND MADE OF GOD'S PROMISE

¹²**O our God, wilt thou not judge them?** for we have no might against this great company that cometh against us; neither know we what to do: but our eyes are upon thee." **2Chronicles20:12**

Jehoshaphat is saying, Lord you promised this... but IF this happens... How can YOUR word be good? Now Jehoshaphat is doing this because He knows, God regards His word above His own name! Jehoshaphat knows God says about His own word shall I NOT make it good, I'm not a man that I should lie!

So God's ears prick when you remind Him of His covenant (not that He forgets but He needs to hear it YOU say it... In order to give Him permission to make it good for YOU!) Remember in Isaiah God says, He answers before you even pray! That simply means the provision has already been made 2Peter1:3 confirms that... NOW all you need to do is ask! You only have not because you ask not!

Now Jehoshaphat told God he didn't know what to do and...

GOD RESPONDS TO JEHOSEPHAT'S DEMAND WITH A COMMAND

Basically acknowledging Jehoshaphat's request and committing to fight this battle for them, because God remembered His promise. So He said to Jehoshaphat "...Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's.

¹⁶To morrow go ye down against them: behold, they come up by the cliff of Ziz; and ye shall find them at the end of the brook, before the wilderness of Jeruel.

¹⁷Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.

¹⁸And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell before the LORD, worshipping the LORD." **2Chronicles20:15-18**

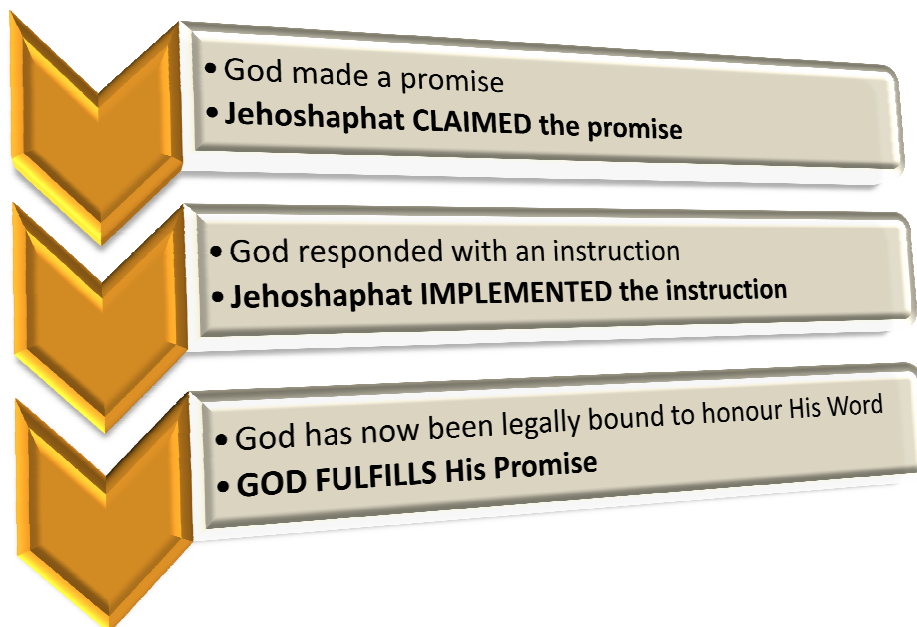
GOD's COMMAND WAS OBEYED

"And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.

²¹And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy endureth for ever." **2Chronicles20:20-21**

PROMISE FULFILLED

Now God is legally obligated to make good on His promise! Why?



²²And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten...

And when Judah came toward the watch tower in the wilderness, they looked unto the multitude, and, behold, they were dead bodies fallen to the earth, and none escaped." **2Chronicles20:22,24**

Now Jehoshaphat was able to make the demands he did, one because He knew He was in right standing with God and second He **KNEW** what God had promised. If He didn't know what God had promised Abraham, the outcome may have been radically different.

**How important do you think it is for YOU to KNOW
what God says, you are entitled to?**

Once You KNOW God's Will Then...

Ask and it IS given, **1 John 5:14-15**. The Promises of God are YES AND Amen! Claim the promises the answer is Yes and so be it!, **Mark 11:24** Yes and Amen His Word is His will.

If it's in the Bible then that's what God's will is... claim it! e.g. **1 John 1:9** God promised says "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." When do you ever pray Lord if it is your will please forgive me. You don't cos you know what God said in 1 John 1:9. Why is it any different with any other promise? THINK ABOUT IT?!

God IS Willing... He says, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning." **James 1:17**, "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away." **Matthew 24:35** "...the LORD WILL give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly." **Psalms 84:11**, "Ask, and it shall be given you;" **Matthew 7:7**,

Jesus says, "...I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them." **Mark 11:23-24**,

YES... "And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive." **Matthew 21:22**,

"Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." **Matthew 18:18**

Faith BEGINS Where the Will of God Is KNOWN! Faith Is In ACTION... When Obedience Is In Place

The Bible says, "...in the mouth of 2 or three witnesses let everything be established" so let me give you another example of a prayer God answered YES to:

"THERE was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia: and his wife was of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elisabeth. And **they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless.** ⁷And they had no child, because that Elisabeth was barren, and they both were now well stricken in years...

But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John." **Luke 1:5-7,13**

Now this example highlights the importance of a different point other than knowing God's Word...

Did you spot what it was?

God being obligated to fulfill His promises is ONLY applicable... once ALL His requirements have been met.

Many think they can get answers to their prayers because they KNOW what the Word says and live in disobedience, let's ask Jesus what He thinks of that:

"...that servant, which knew his lord's will, and prepared not himself, neither did according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes." **Luke12:47,**

"And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, **because we keep** his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight." **1John3:22**

"...the LORD WILL give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold **from them that walk uprightly.**" **Ps84:11**

**Outside of obedience, you
will never find power!

Why God is **LIKELY** To Answer **YOUR** Prayer!

"And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples. ²And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.

³Give us day by day our daily bread. ⁴And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. ⁵And he said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves;

⁶For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him? ⁷And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee. ⁸I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as many as he needeth.

⁹And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. ¹⁰For **EVERY one** that asketh receiveth..." **Luke11:1-10,**

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you: For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God" **John16:23-24, 26-27.**

So now you know this... I suggest to you that When you make your request known with praise and thanksgiving, that you bare in mind. What Jesus' brother James said:

"But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. ⁷For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord." **James1:6-7,**

Remember we can't please God without faith and Jesus said in Matthew, "According to YOUR faith be it unto you..." When the woman with the issue of blood in faith touched Jesus garment and she was healed. What did Jesus say to her? "...Daughter, be of good comfort: THY faith hath made thee whole; go in peace..." **Luke8:48**

Faith vs Wavering Faith and it's RESULTS... When Jesus was about to do any miracle He required the faith of either the recipient or the person making request on the recipients' behalf...

I'm gonna share a text with you and I want you to pay close attention, to spot how important faith is to moving the Hand of God! Luke 8 tells the story of when a father had the intention of asking Jesus to heal his daughter and someone from his household told him. In no uncertain terms look your daughter has died there is no point bothering Jesus now...

⁵⁰But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, **Fear not: believe ONLY**, and she shall be made whole. ⁵¹And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in (**I wonder why?**), save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden.

⁵²And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth. ⁵³And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead. ⁵⁴And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise." **Luke 8:50-54.**

Did you pick up on what Jesus did and said?

He said: He required faith NO wavering! "Fear not: believe ONLY"

He DID this: He allowed no man to go into the house except a select few! He put them all out! (**I wonder why?**) He did this because God is not pleased by those absent of faith! Only those with faith were allowed in! And only then did God move!

One Who Had Faith...

"And it came to pass, when he was in a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy: who seeing Jesus fell on his face, and besought him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. ¹³And he put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will: be thou clean. And immediately the leprosy departed from him." **Luke 5:12-13,**

One Whose Faith Wavered...

"And Zacharias said unto the angel, **Whereby shall I know this?** for I am an old man, and my wife well stricken in years. And the angel answering said unto him, I am Gabriel, that stand in the presence of God; and am sent to speak unto thee, and to shew thee these glad tidings. ²⁰And, behold, thou shalt be dumb, and not able to speak, until the day that these things shall be performed, **because thou believest not** my words, which shall be fulfilled in their season." **Luke 1:18-20,**

One Who Had Faith...

Mary received news that she would be the mother of the Saviour of this world... "Then said Mary unto the angel, **How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?** And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

³⁶And, behold, thy cousin Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son in her old age: and this is the sixth month with her, who was called barren. ³⁷**For with God nothing shall be impossible.** ³⁸And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; **be it unto me according to thy word.** And the angel departed from her...

And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord." **Luke1:34-38,45.**

Your Faith filled prayer, NOT Wavering...

Since we know ALL scripture is given by inspiration of God. We can say, Lord I know, I know you said, you will do (this) God never turns around and says sorry that's not my will anymore, I've made an amendment to my constitution, He will not alter his Word or break his covenant, He is The Lord He changes not and with Him is no variableness neither shadow of turning! He is the same today yesterday forever! He is consistently watching over His word to perform it, He puts His word above His own name.

"...let them pray... in the name of the Lord: ¹⁵And **the prayer of faith shall save...** the Lord shall... ¹⁶**...The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.** ¹⁷Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he **prayed earnestly** that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. ¹⁸And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit." **James5:14-18.**

JESUS Promised When YOU Pray... Things WILL HAPPEN!

"Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake. ¹²Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. ¹³And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴**If ye shall ask ANY thing in my name, I WILL do it.**" **John14:11-14,**

"If ye abide in me, and **my words** abide in you, **ye shall ask what YE will, and it SHALL be done unto you...**" **John15:7,16** Tell Me what I told you, it will be done BECAUSE they are my words and My words are spirit and they are life they have creative energy. My words don't return to me void they accomplish that which I please! Jesus is effectively saying;

Pray According To His Will... which is HIS Word! And that leaves no room for questions as to whether or not He will do what He said.

Whatever You Want... ASK Using MY Words and it IS Done!

When you go to God and say **"You Promised."** I believe those are the 2 most powerful words you can ever go to the throne room of the king of this universe and say.

So go to Him filled with confidence and Go BODILY... Because when you go to His throne armed with HIS Word, you can go without the fear of rejection or denile!

Before you invested in this program, I gave you my word I would give you access to it... Was there ever any doubt that it would be delivered to you, once you'd made the investment? No! So why would you have more confidence in me, (a man that can lie) making good on my word, than in the God who can't lie?

What To Do After You Pray... (When Waiting for Manifestation)

What you say in prayer is important, what you DO after you pray is vital.

You NEED to STAY in faith... REMEMBER Mark4 with the seed and soil. Make sure your heart is the last type of soil Jesus mentioned! Why? Because Jesus said, "...According to YOUR faith be it unto you."

Matthew9:29,

QUOTE FROM: Heavenly Places April 16

Now there can be delays which in your view are taking entirely too long. I'm sure you don't need me to tell you there is a good reason, whatever it may be!

All I can say is according to **Proverbs10:22**, "The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it."

God hasn't delivered because there are still things in the way, you don't see or things He needs to show you which you need to correct, so you are in line with His will and not hindering giving Him permission to honour His Word. It could be He is using this as an opportunity for you to grow your patience and increase your faith: "But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. ⁹The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." **2Peter3:8-9.**

Cultivate Enduring Faith "Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts..."

. ¹⁰Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience. ¹¹Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy." **James5:7,8, 10-11,**

"Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded." **1Peter2:2,6**

"For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil." **1Peter3:12.**

So Bear in mind when you prayed, you spoke to a real person, who heard you and HAS answered you and answered BEFORE you called. "...stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:" **2Peter3:1**

***ALWAYS Think...**
"What I requested IS on it's way!"
SEE it from the end*

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen... Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear." **Hebrews 11:1,3**

GET into gratitude for it and stay there. Thank Him for what has manifested. Encourage yourself in His Word which is all you have and thankfully a living God who Honours it.

PRAYER & FAITH

I have a great quote that ties all this in together it's taken from a book called Early Writings p72-73 it says:

"I have frequently seen that the children of the Lord neglect prayer, especially secret prayer, altogether too much; that many do not exercise that faith which it is their privilege and duty to exercise, often waiting for that feeling which faith alone can bring. Feeling is not faith; the two are distinct. Faith is ours to exercise, but joyful feeling and the blessing are God's to give. The grace of God comes to the soul through the channel of living faith, and that faith it is in our power to exercise.

True faith lays hold of and claims the promised blessing before it is realized and felt. We must send up our petitions in faith within the second veil and let our faith take hold of the promised blessing and claim it as ours. **We are then to believe that we receive the blessing, because our faith has hold of it, and according to the Word it is ours.** "What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them." Mark 11:24. Here is faith, naked faith, to **believe that we receive the blessing, even before we realize it.** When the promised blessing is realized and enjoyed, faith is swallowed up. But many suppose they have much faith when sharing largely of the Holy Spirit and that they cannot have faith unless they feel the power of the Spirit. Such confound faith with the blessing that comes through faith. **The very time to exercise faith is when we feel destitute of the**



Spirit. When thick clouds of darkness seem to hover over the mind, then is the time to let living faith pierce the darkness and scatter the clouds. True faith rests on the promises contained in the Word of God, and **those only who obey that Word can claim its glorious promises.** "If ye abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you." John 15:7. "Whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight." 1 John 3:22.

We should be much in secret prayer. Christ is the vine, ye are the branches. And if we would grow and flourish, we must continually draw sap and nourishment from the Living Vine; for separated from the Vine we have no strength.

I asked the angel why there was no more faith and power in Israel. He said, "Ye let go of the arm of the Lord too soon. Press your petitions to the throne, and hold on by strong faith. **The promises are sure.** Believe ye receive the things ye ask for, and ye shall have them." I was then pointed to Elijah. He was subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly. His faith endured the trial. Seven times

he prayed before the Lord, and at last the cloud was seen. I saw that we had doubted the sure promises, and wounded the Saviour by our lack of faith. Said the angel, "Gird the armor about thee, and above all take the shield of faith; for that will guard the heart, the very life, from the fiery darts of the wicked." If the enemy can lead the desponding to take their eyes off from Jesus, and look to themselves, and dwell upon their own unworthiness, instead of dwelling upon the worthiness of Jesus, His love, His merits, and His great mercy, he will get away their shield of faith and gain his object; they will be exposed to his fiery temptations. The weak should therefore look to Jesus, and believe in Him; they then exercise faith." (**Early Writings p72-73**)

You Need To Cultivate a HABITUAL Attitude of Trust

BECAUSE Every right prayer is answered before the prayer itself is finished--before we have "done speaking." This is because God has pledged His Word to us that whatsoever we ask in Christ's name (that is, in oneness with Christ and His will) and in faith, shall be done.

As God's Word cannot fail, whenever we meet those simple conditions in prayer, the answer to our prayer has been granted and completed in Heaven as we pray, even though its appearance on earth may not occur until long afterward.

So it's good practice to close every prayer with praise to God for the answer that He has already granted; He who never forsakes His loving-kindness or His word. (See Daniel 9:20-27 and Daniel 10:12.) "...from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words."

When we believe for a blessing, we must take the attitude of faith, and begin to act and pray as if we had the blessing. We must treat God as if He had given us our request. We must lean our weight over upon Him for the thing that we have claimed, and just take it for granted that He gives it, and is going to continue to give it. This is the attitude of trust.

How do you pray the prayer OF FAITH? Simple...
You pray FULLY PERSUADED God WILL fulfill His Word that you are praying according to!

How To Pray The Prayer God NEVER Says “No” To!

1. **Get into the HABIT of Finding God’s Promise...** for what it is you’re praying for! Before you pray... In fact don’t ever approach His throne without His Word! If you CAN’T FIND ONE ask God to show you! He Promises He Will!

What To Do When God’s Will Isn’t Clearly Outlined In His Word!

“For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither any thing hid, that shall not be known and come abroad.” **Luke8:17.**

“Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.” **Jeremiah33:3.**

“Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But **God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit**; for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. ¹¹For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.” **2Corinthians2:9-11.**

2. **Meditate on God’s Promises...** Think on them until you believe that promise is more likely to be fulfilled than the reality you face lasting OR God’s promise is more real to you than the reality.. (Joshua1:8 Romans12:2) Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God.

3. **Pray According to God’s Promise...** expecting (at the point WHEN you pray) that God will do as He has promised. (That’s why I said to meditate so that you are confident in God’s promise before you pray)

4. **Wait Patiently...** giving thanks in faith His promise is already fulfilled!



EXAMPLE of: How To Pray The Prayer God NEVER Says “No” to!

And I’m going to use (Prayer for Victory Over Sin) as an example.

God has given His power to everybody to overcome sin. “But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to **them that believe** on his name:” **John1:12**

If you believe in the name of Jesus Christ, that means you believe in all of the power that He has made available to humanity. If you BELIEVE He can give you victory over sin and you place your faith IN Him, He CAN give you victory!

What you need is the MIND OF CHRIST. Did you know that the Bible has promised you, that we can be recipients of the mind of Christ! **Phillipians2:5** “Let THIS mind be IN YOU that was also in Christ Jesus.” If we have the mind of Christ we can BE like Christ.

And the Bible tells us what the mind of Christ IS CAPABLE OF... 1Peter4:1 “Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, **arm yourselves also with the SAME mind**, for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin that he **no longer** should live the rest of *his* time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but **for the will of God.**”

What I’m saying is the mind of Christ has the capability to cease from sin and be OBEDIENT to the desires of the WILL of God.

So what you do... is with that in mind (that’s KNOWING having Christ’s mind means freedom) you pray expecting God to give you Christ’s mind and that with that mind will come a change in heart’s desires. You have to pray EXPECTING this will happen!

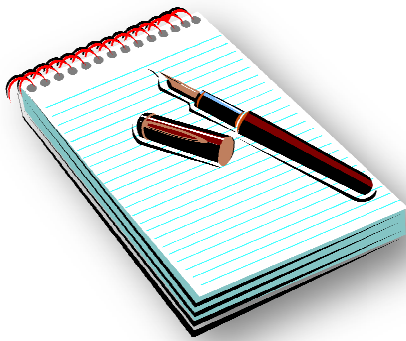
If you plead earnestly as we learned in module2 for the MIND of Christ. According to **1John5:14-15** He WILL give it to you! We just read that this is what God wants us to do. So therefore you are praying according to His Will and He WILLs to do it, you know you have the petition that you have desired of Him! You will be granted the mind of Christ and with the mind of Christ comes the desire to do the will of God and by default ceases from sin!

“For it is God which worketh in you both **to will** and to do of his good pleasure.” **Phillipians2:13** We are instructed to command the work of God’s hands in our lives according to Isaiah45:11. Ask God for Christ’s mind, ask God to make you WILLING! He’ll do it! Ask God for power and He will not only give you the strength to obey Him but in addition to it He will give you a LOVE to obey Him!

But you have to ask! And you have to be diligent go back to module2 if you need to! You have to seek it out with all of your heart mind and soul with the EXPECTATION of God answering! And when you do this God won’t turn you away! He will bless you with the answers to your prayer that you stand in need of! We have His promise we can do all things through Christ which strengthens us!

And therefore we can stand boldly and proclaim before all the eyes of heaven... “I thank you FATHER for appropriating the merits of Christ blood shed for me. I thank you that because I have prayed according to YOUR perfect & divine will, you HAVE heard me and answered my prayer in Jesus name, I have the petition, I ask believing in my heart I HAVE what I prayed for because everyone that asketh receives. In Jesus name Let it BE so...”

Ok so Now I want YOU to do this!!!
