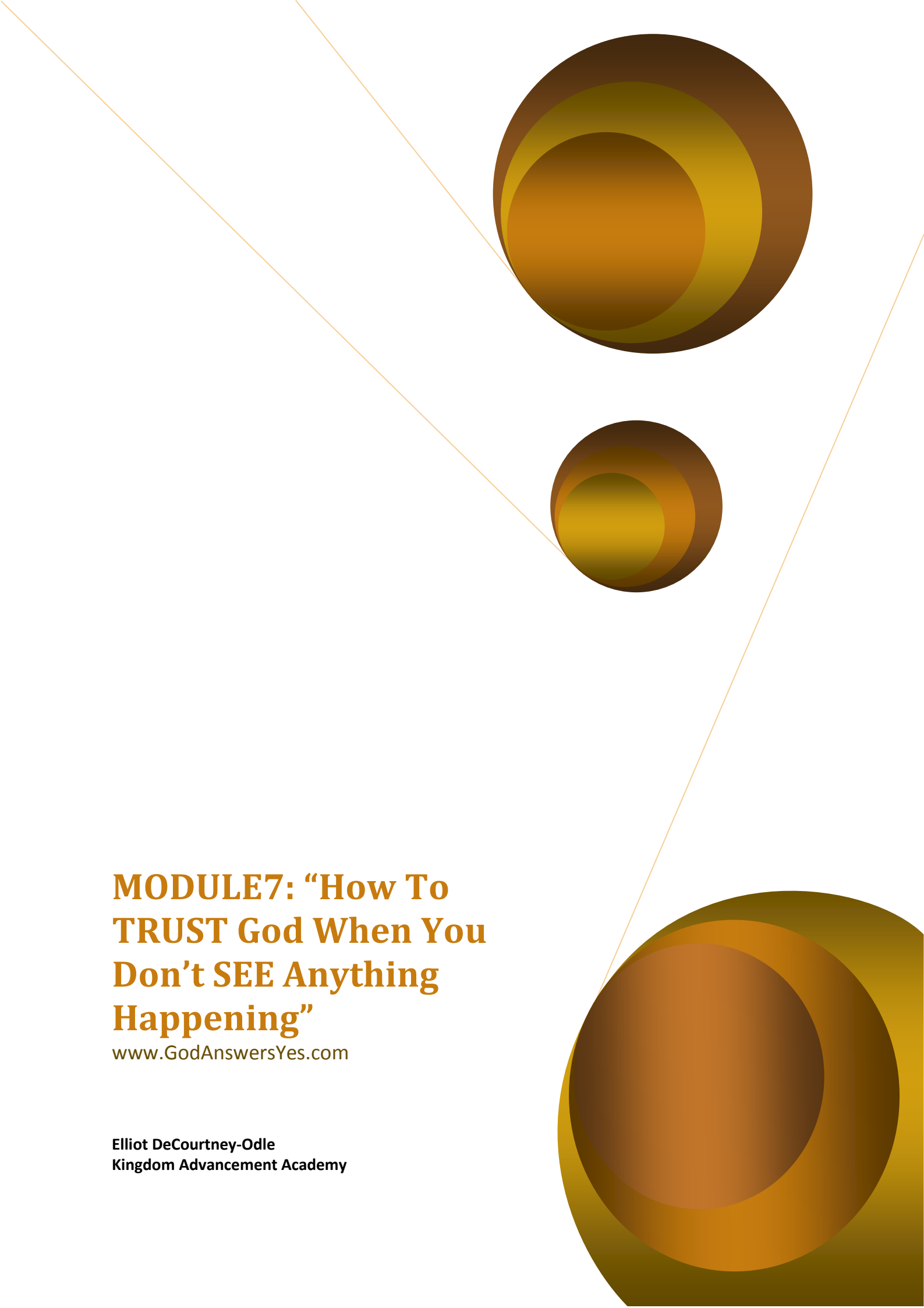

BUT...
What You DO **AFTER** Is Vital*

"Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. ³⁶For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise... ³⁸Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.."

Think of your prayer like Cement... you've set in the right place, you've done the will of God... now let it dry, and be hardened... You're faith that is... ONLY BELIEVE

You should be as stubborn as a mule... (Once you pray your faith should be like a brick stuck in the cement of God's Word, you prayed, you believed WHEN you prayed that you received... now stay stuck on that promise let it dry and may your heart be hardened to anything contrary to the Word of God) ONLY BELIEVE what God promised...

Here's Something You Should Understand... BEFORE God made any promise and had it recorded in His Word... He had ALREADY worked out how exactly He would make each and every individual promise He ever made come to pass for each individual who ever lives on this earth so that when they claim it, there will not be a single promise He could ever be accused of breaking... You say AMEN because it is Done before you prayed...

Listen to this quote from: **The Great Controversy**

"We can so far comprehend His dealings with us, and the motives by which He is actuated, that we may discern boundless love and mercy united to infinite power. Our Father in heaven orders everything in wisdom and righteousness, and we are not to be dissatisfied and distrustful, but to bow in reverent submission. He will reveal to us as much of His purposes as it is for our good to know, and beyond that we must trust the Hand that is omnipotent, the Heart that is full of love.

While God has given ample evidence for faith, He will never remove all excuse for unbelief. All who look for hooks to hang their doubts upon will find them. And those who refuse to accept and obey God's word until every objection has been removed, and there is no longer an opportunity for doubt, will never come to the light.

Distrust of God is the natural outgrowth of the unrenewed heart, which is at enmity with Him. But faith is inspired by the Holy Spirit, and it will flourish only as it is cherished. No man can become strong in faith without a determined effort. Unbelief strengthens as it is encouraged; and if men, instead of dwelling upon the evidences which God has given to sustain their faith, permit themselves to question and cavil, they will find their doubts constantly becoming more confirmed.

But those who doubt God's promises and distrust the assurance of His grace are dishonoring Him...

There is but one course for those to pursue who honestly desire to be freed from doubts. Instead of questioning and caviling concerning that which they do not understand, let them give heed to the light which already shines upon them, and they will receive greater light. Let them do every duty which has been made plain to their understanding, and they will be enabled to understand and perform those of which they are now in doubt.

...The followers of Christ know little of the plots which Satan and his hosts are forming against them. But He who sitteth in the heavens will overrule all these devices for the accomplishment of His deep designs. The Lord permits His people to be subjected to the fiery ordeal of temptation, not because He takes pleasure in their distress and affliction, but because this process is essential to their final

victory. He could not, consistently with His own glory, shield them from temptation; for the very object of the trial is to prepare them to resist all the allurements of evil.

Neither wicked men nor devils can hinder the work of God, or shut out His presence from His people, if they will, with subdued, contrite hearts, confess and put away their sins, and in faith claim His promises. Every temptation, every opposing influence, whether open or secret, may be successfully resisted, "not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit, saith the Lord of hosts." Zechariah 4:6.



"The eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and His ears are open unto their prayers. . . . And who is he that will harm you, if ye be followers of that which is good?" 1 Peter 3:12, 13. When Balaam, allured by the promise of rich rewards, practiced enchantments against Israel, and by sacrifices to the Lord sought to invoke a curse upon His people, the Spirit of God forbade the evil which he longed to pronounce, and Balaam was forced to exclaim: "How shall I curse, whom God hath not cursed? or how shall I defy, whom the Lord hath not defied?" "Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his!" When sacrifice had again been offered, the ungodly prophet declared: "Behold, I have received commandment to bless: and He hath blessed; and I cannot reverse it. He hath not beheld iniquity in Jacob, neither hath He seen perverseness in Israel: the Lord his God is with him, and the shout of a King is among them." "Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, neither is there any divination against Israel: according to this time it shall be said of Jacob and of Israel, What hath God wrought!" Yet a third time altars were erected, and again Balaam essayed to secure a curse. But from the unwilling lips of the prophet, the Spirit of God declared the prosperity of His chosen, and rebuked the folly and malice of their foes: "Blessed is he that blesseth thee, and cursed is he that curseth thee." Numbers 23:8, 10, 20, 21, 23; 24:9.

The people of Israel were at this time loyal to God; and so long as they continued in obedience to His law, no power in earth or hell could prevail against them. But the curse which Balaam had not been permitted to pronounce against God's people, he finally succeeded in bringing upon them by seducing them into sin. When they transgressed God's commandments, then they separated themselves from Him, and they were left to feel the power of the destroyer.

Satan is well aware that the weakest soul who abides in Christ is more than a match for the hosts of darkness, and that, should he reveal himself openly, he would be met and resisted. Therefore he seeks to draw away the soldiers of the cross from their strong fortification, while he lies in ambush with his forces, ready to destroy all who venture upon his ground. Only in humble reliance upon God, and obedience to all His commandments, can we be secure.

No man is safe for a day or an hour without prayer. Especially should we entreat the Lord for wisdom to understand His word. Here are revealed the wiles of the tempter and the means by which he may be successfully resisted. Satan is an expert in quoting Scripture, placing his own interpretation upon passages, by which he hopes to cause us to stumble. We should study the Bible with humility of heart, never losing sight of our dependence upon God. While we must constantly guard against the devices of Satan, we should pray in faith continually: "Lead us not into temptation." **The Great Controversy p527-530**

How Others TRUSTED God

WHAT OTHERS DID WHEN DISCOURAGING CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDED THEM

Hezekiah, "Almighty God has wonderfully recorded for us all record upon record of people who went through challenging times, even impossible situations, yet, had dramatic victories, when they turned to the Lord for help. Yes, since the lord is **no respecter of persons** (Acts 10:34) we can be assured of His help and miracle working power when we ask for His help.

King Hezekiah was being tormented with the news that the great Assyrian army was going to crush his Jerusalem if they didn't surrender to the enemy king. All other nations had been defeated and they were next. The Assyrian king promised if Hezekiah would seek help from Egypt or to trust in their God of Israel, they would be destroyed either way. Fear gripped Hezekiah, yet, the bible says...

"Hezekiah received the letter from the hand of the messengers, and read it: **and Hezekiah went up unto the house of the LORD, and spread it before the LORD.**" **Isaiah 37:14**

He took the entire matter to God. He turned from the help of mere mortals... and went before Him who is... *immortal & eternal!*



Isaiah 37:15 says, "**And Hezekiah prayed unto the LORD.** Now let us learn from his prayer which God had recorded for us..."

"O LORD of hosts (**armies**), God of Israel, that dwellest between the cherubims, thou art the God, even thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth. Thou hast made heaven and earth." **Isaiah 37:16**

This is a great way to start any prayer for help! To first recognize and voice out who your God really is! Who is He...? Creator of the heavens and the earth and ruler over *all*! As Hezekiah addressed God in this way... his faith arose... and, his picture of God's all-mighty-ness got bigger and bigger! Folks, his 'problem'... the 'great' army of Assyria and the mortal king's threats downsized to nothing-ness.

Now for Hezekiah's Request...

"Now therefore, O LORD our God, save us from his hand, so that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that thou art the LORD, even thou only." **Isaiah 37:20** (His will according to Deuteronomy)

Hezekiah wanted God to deliver them in such a way that ALL the world would KNOW that their God... IS God! Yes, our God is indeed... the awesome God! The scripture goes on to reveal that God sent 1 angel into the enemies camp the next morning and slew 185,000 combat-ready troops! Next, the king of Assyria rushed home... and, made a bee-line to his temple to worship his 'god'. And, just as he bowed down to his idol, his own 2 sons snuck up behind and smote him with their swords! Wow! What a mighty answer to prayer!

Friends, from now onwards, let us also pray in like manner. Let us not just ask the Lord to remove the problem... *NO!* Let us intreat Him to do so in such a way that our families, our communities, our city and nation must KNOW... that our deliverance came *ONLY* from our God, creator of heaven and earth! The one and only God! Amen!

Psalms126:1-2 says, "When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream. Then, was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the nations, The LORD hath done great things for them."

Verse 4 continues, "**Turn again our captivity, O LORD!**"

Yes, God is ready to do it again! to heal us again, to forgive us again, to free us again, to lift us up again! And, this time, He will make it seem like we are dreaming! Are you ready? Then,... spread *your* 'letter' out before the Lord!"

David encouraged HIMSELF, in the Lord... In the Lord and in His Word. His promises.

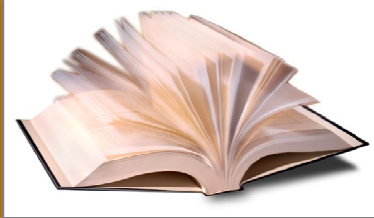
How YOU Should Trust God

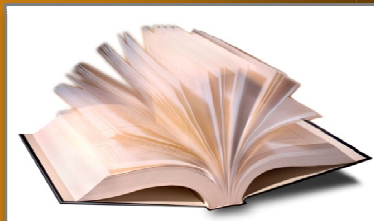

e.g. **You Want Your Friend to be Saved...** "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." **2Peter3:9,**

Work your part "The lesson is for all in positions of trust. Here's how you tell... At the first sign of opposition, against God's Word... WITHOUT EVEN THINKING, your first response is what God's Promise says!

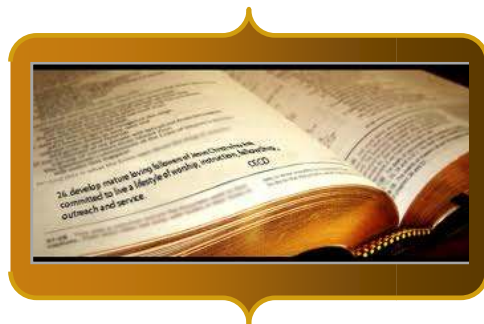
As a man thinks in His heart so is He! God's Word is in The Abundance of Your Heart!

KEEP Your Thoughts as PRISONERS To What God Said...

"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things." **Phillipians4:8**

Don't allow yourself to ponder anything other than what God says!

This is why I say meditate, because out the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. If I get God's Word in ABUNDANCE in my heart, then the only thing my mouth will speak is the Word. ENCOURAGE YOURSELF IN THE LORD Think of a time you needed God to come though and He did. And know that God is the SAME yesterday, today and FOREVER "Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life:" **Deuteronomy4:9**

Jacob did this when God said to him, "Behold I am with thee, and will keep thee in all places whether thou goest, and will bring thee again in this land (**OR "will bring you to the PROMISE you claim"**) For I WILL NOT LEAVE THEE **UNTIL** I have done that which I have spoken unto thee of" **Genesis28:15**

"No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD." **Isaiah54:17.**

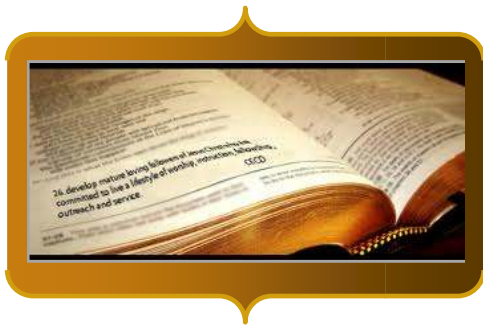


""With deep gratitude he repeated the promise that God's presence would be with him; and then he made the solemn vow, "If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on, so that I come again to my father's house in peace; then shall the Lord be my God: and this stone, which I have set for a pillar, shall be God's house: and of all that Thou shalt give me I will surely give the tenth unto Thee..."

Reflect On What YOU Expect GOD To Do As If It IS Done! (Assurance of FUTURE)



"...to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

¹⁷(As it is written, **I HAVE** made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and **calleth those things which be not as though they were.**

¹⁸Who **against hope believed in hope**, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.¹⁹ And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb:

²⁰**He staggered not at the promise** of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

²¹And **being fully persuaded** that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform."
Romans 4:16-21

You can be assured God's promises to you will be fulfilled, if you will follow the things I've shared with you so far, in this programme. There is supernatural activity working on behalf of every one who God calls His child.

Take Elisha for Example:

"...Elisha, the prophet that is in Israel, telleth the king of Israel the words that thou speakest in thy bedchamber."...

In terror Elisha's servant sought him with the tidings. "Alas, my master!" he said, "how shall we do?"

"Fear not," was the answer of the prophet; "for they that be with us are more than they that be with them." And then, that the servant might know this for himself, "Elisha prayed, and said, Lord, I pray Thee, open his eyes, that he may see." "The Lord opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha." Between the servant



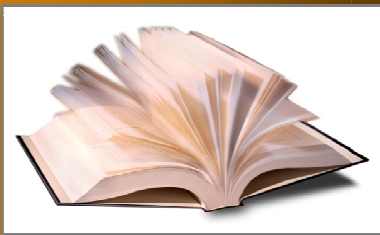
of God and the hosts of armed foemen was an encircling band of heavenly angels. They had come down in mighty power, not to destroy, not to exact homage, but to encamp round about and minister to the Lord's weak and helpless ones. (We have the same promise "The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them." **Psalms 34:7**)

When the people of God are brought into strait places, and apparently there is no escape for them, the Lord alone must be their dependence." **p256-257 Prophets & Kings**

*If your eyes could be opened and SAW Heaven's provisions that are working FOR You, you would be so confident, **you wouldn't even need faith!***

Faith is evidence of things NOT seen. But God said "the just shall LIVE by faith. For we Walk by faith not by sight. Just trust what God says is there... IS there! "God is not a man, that he should lie... hath he said, and shall he not do it?..." **Numbers23:19**

God doesn't let us see the supernatural activity going on, on our behalf, but He assures us as members of His church that obedience to His commands are the only thing we need be concerned with...
